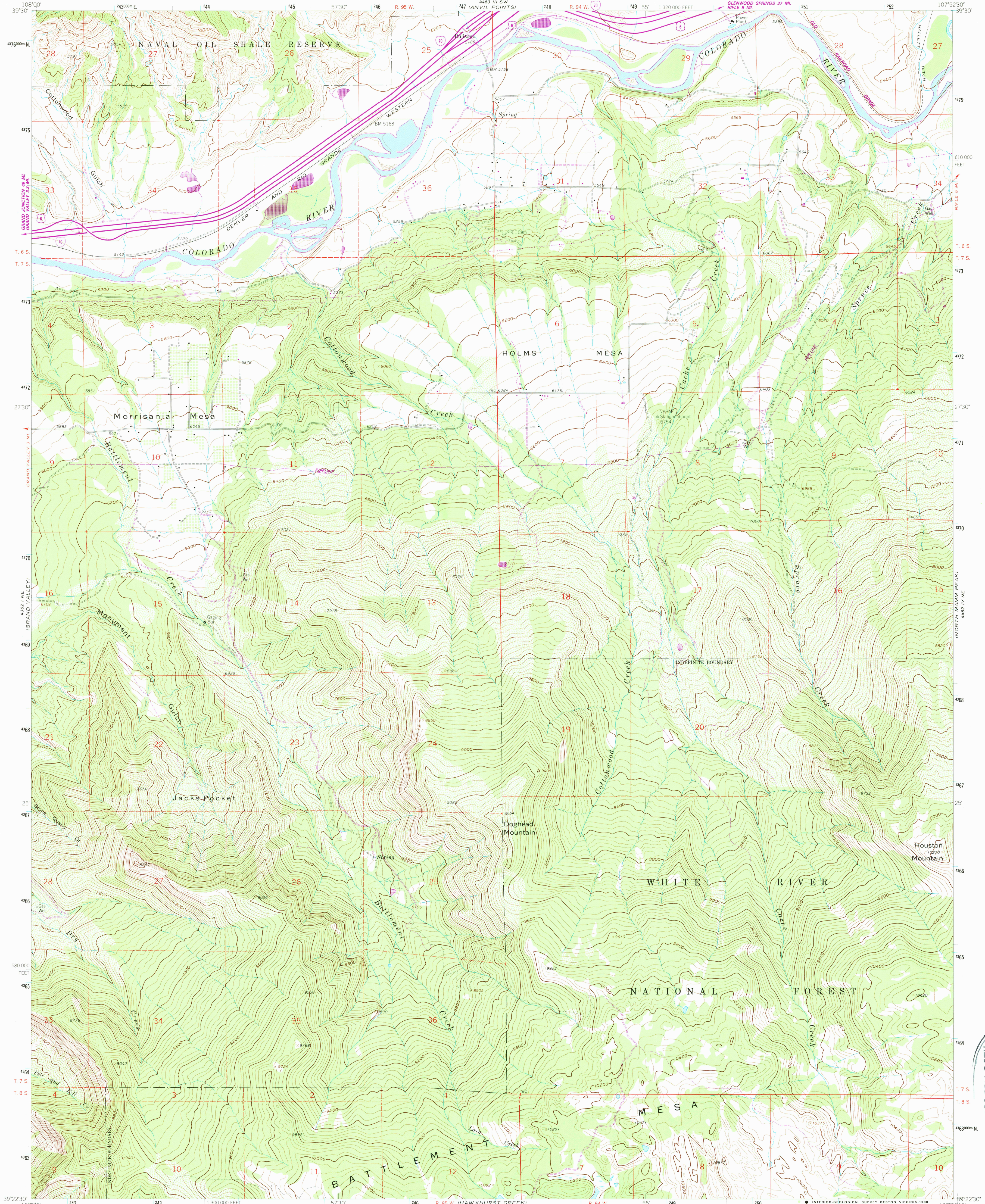

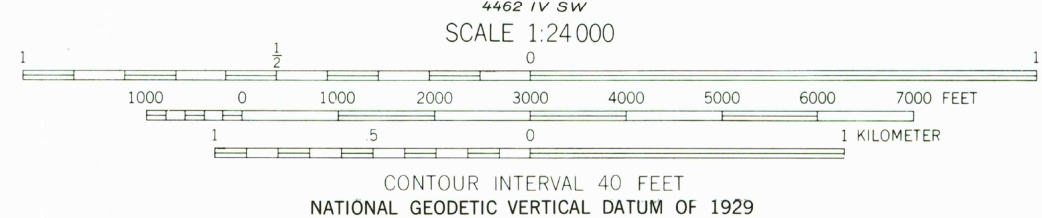
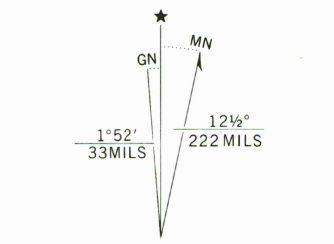
Topography by photogrammetric methods from aerial photographs taken 1956. Field checked 1960

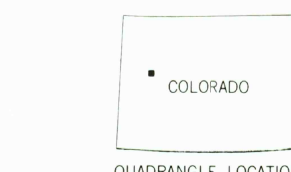
Where omitted, land lines have not been established. Fine red dashed lines indicate selected fence lines
