1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks, zone 13, shown in blue

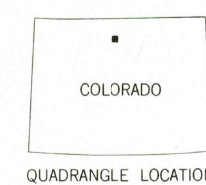
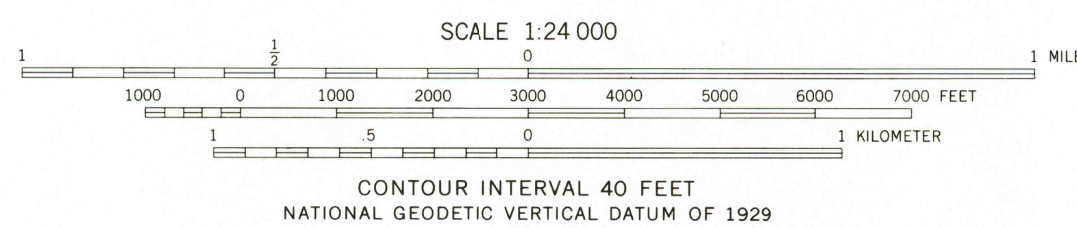
Dashed land lines indicate approximate locations
