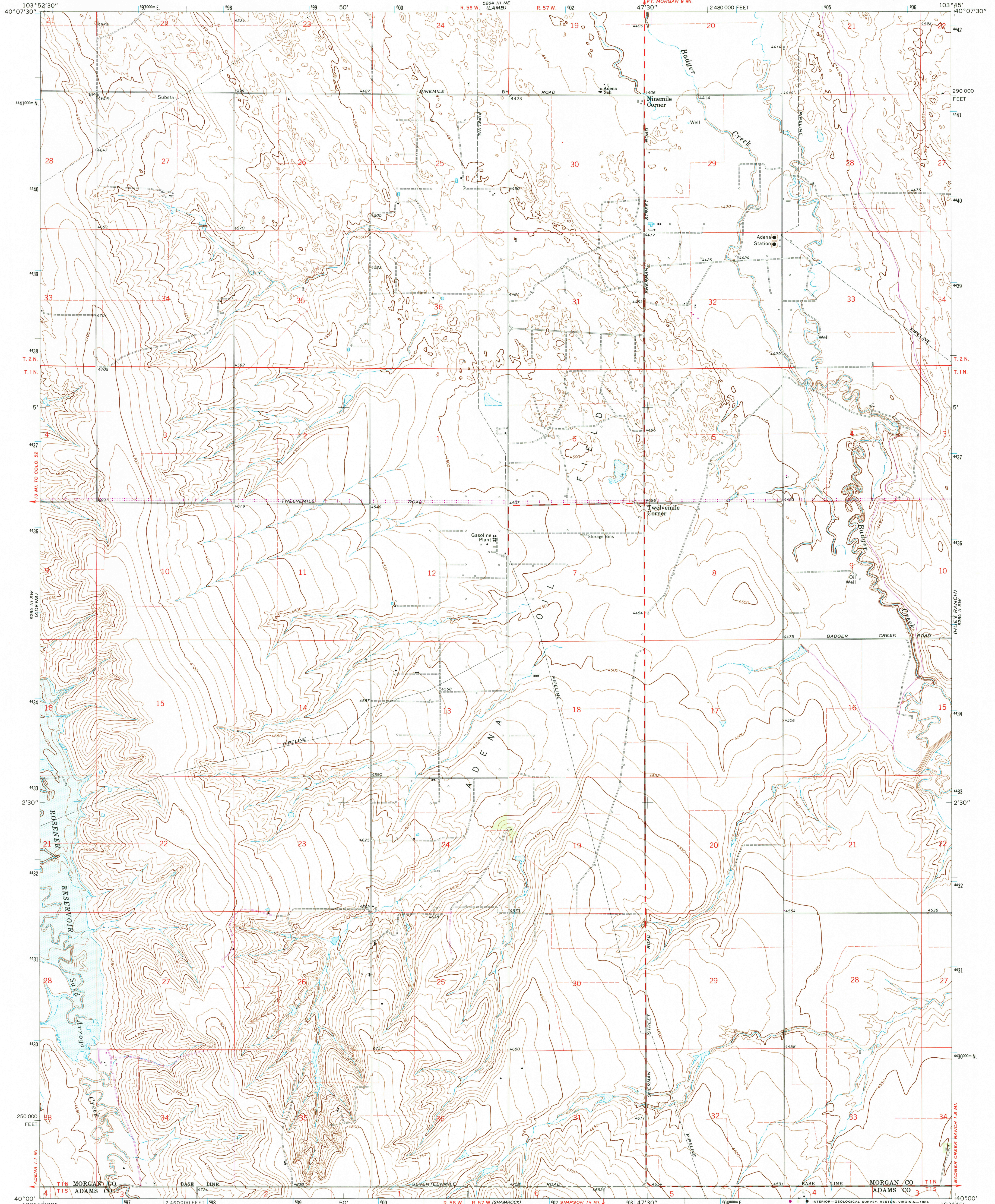

Polycyclic projection. 10,000-foot grid ticks based on Colorado coordinate system, north zone

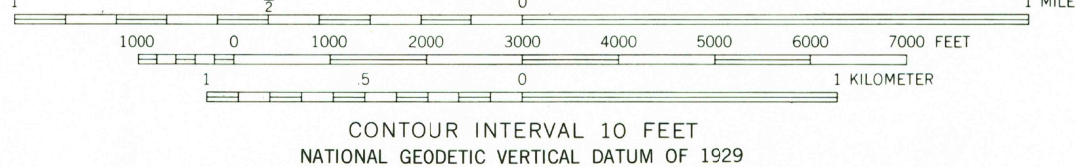
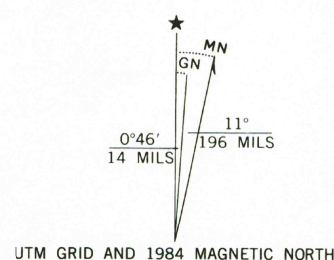
1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks, zone 13, shown in blue

To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983 move the projection lines 5 meters north and 44 meters east as shown by dashed corner ticks

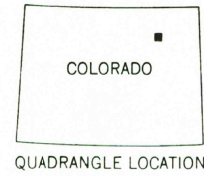
Areas covered by dashed light-blue pattern are subject to controlled inundation
