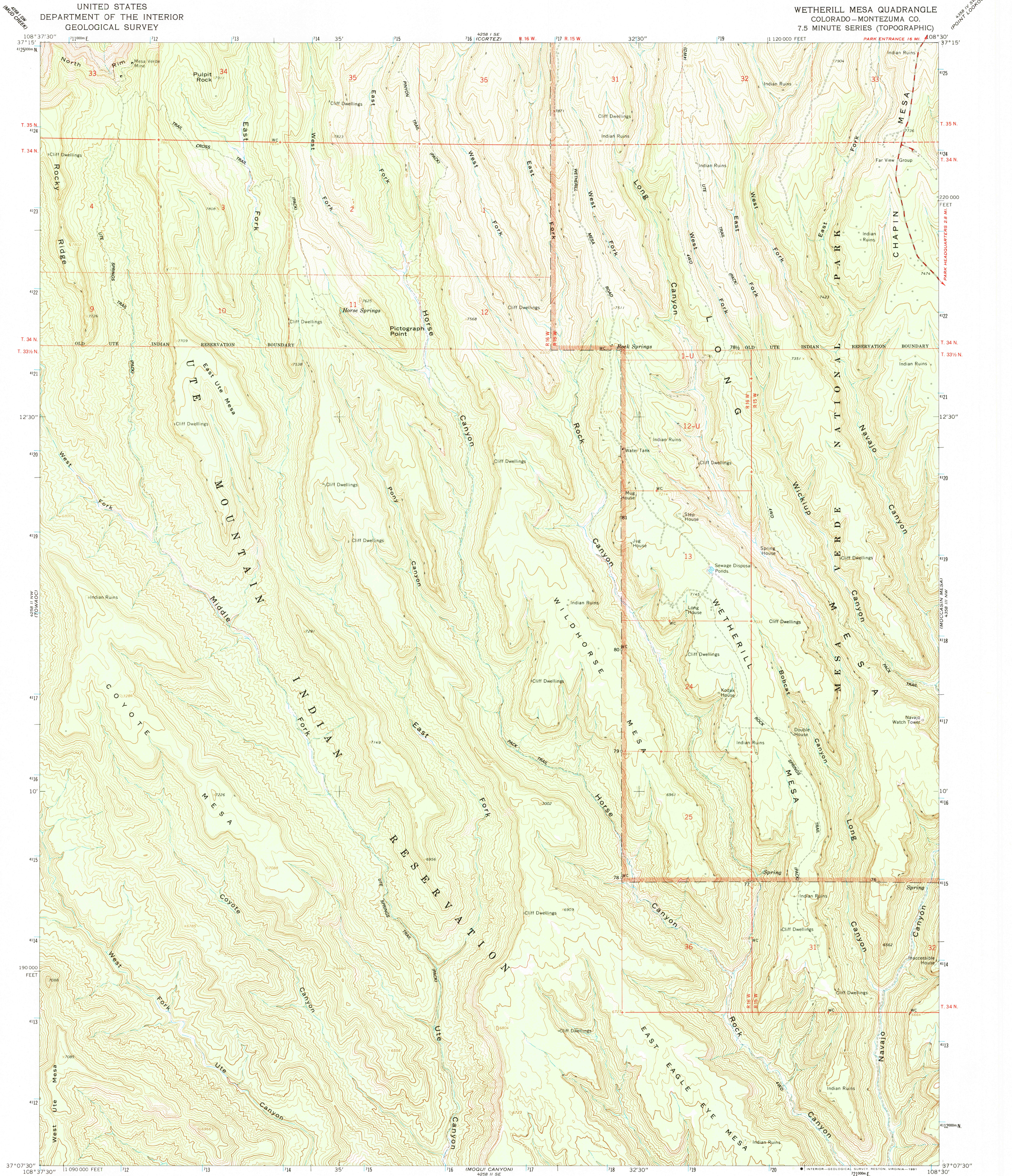

Polyconic projection. 1927 North American Datum. 10,000-foot grid based on Colorado coordinate system, south zone

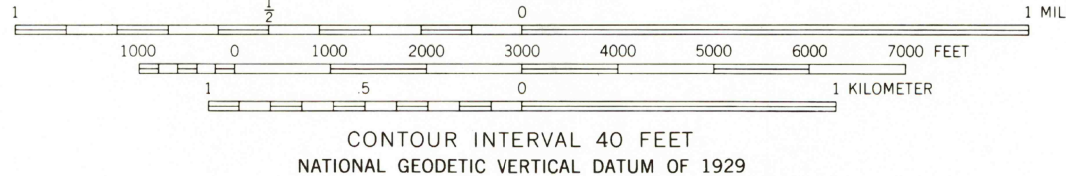
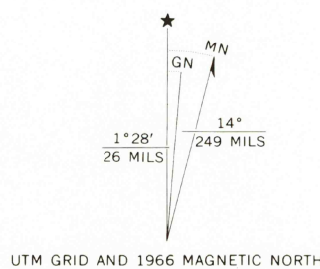
1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks, zone 12, shown in blue
