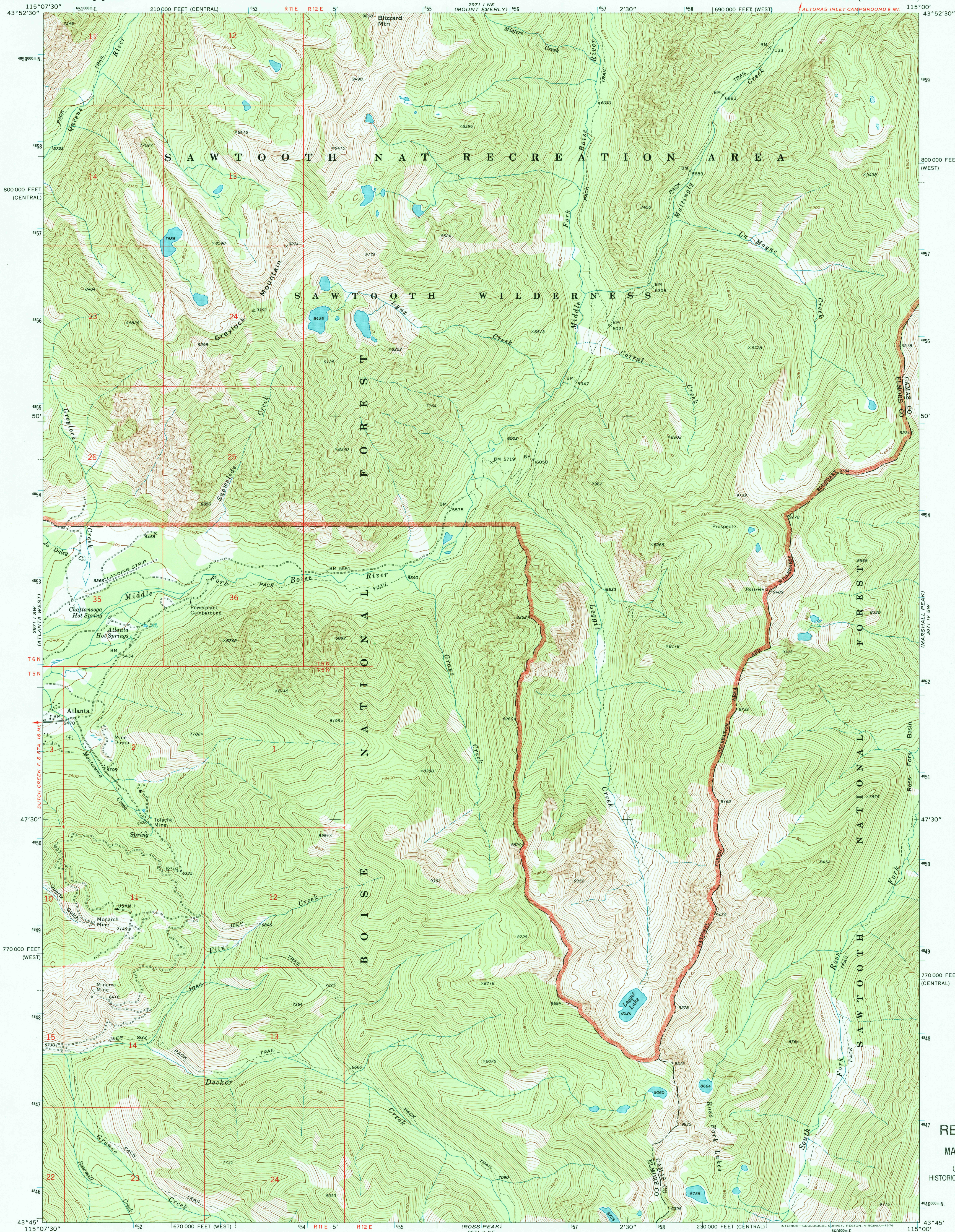

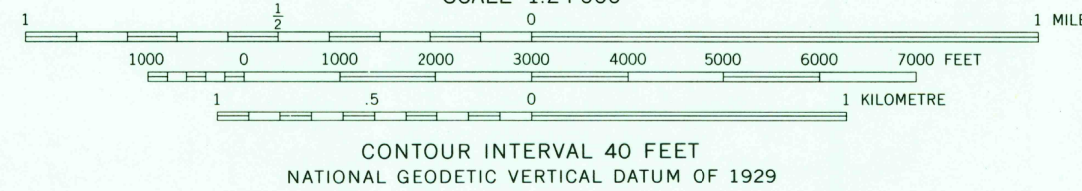
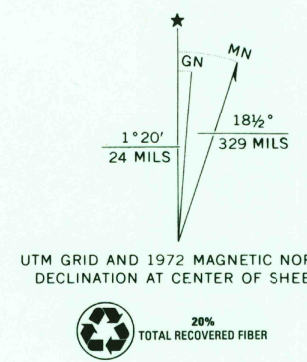
10,000-foot grid ticks based on Idaho coordinate
