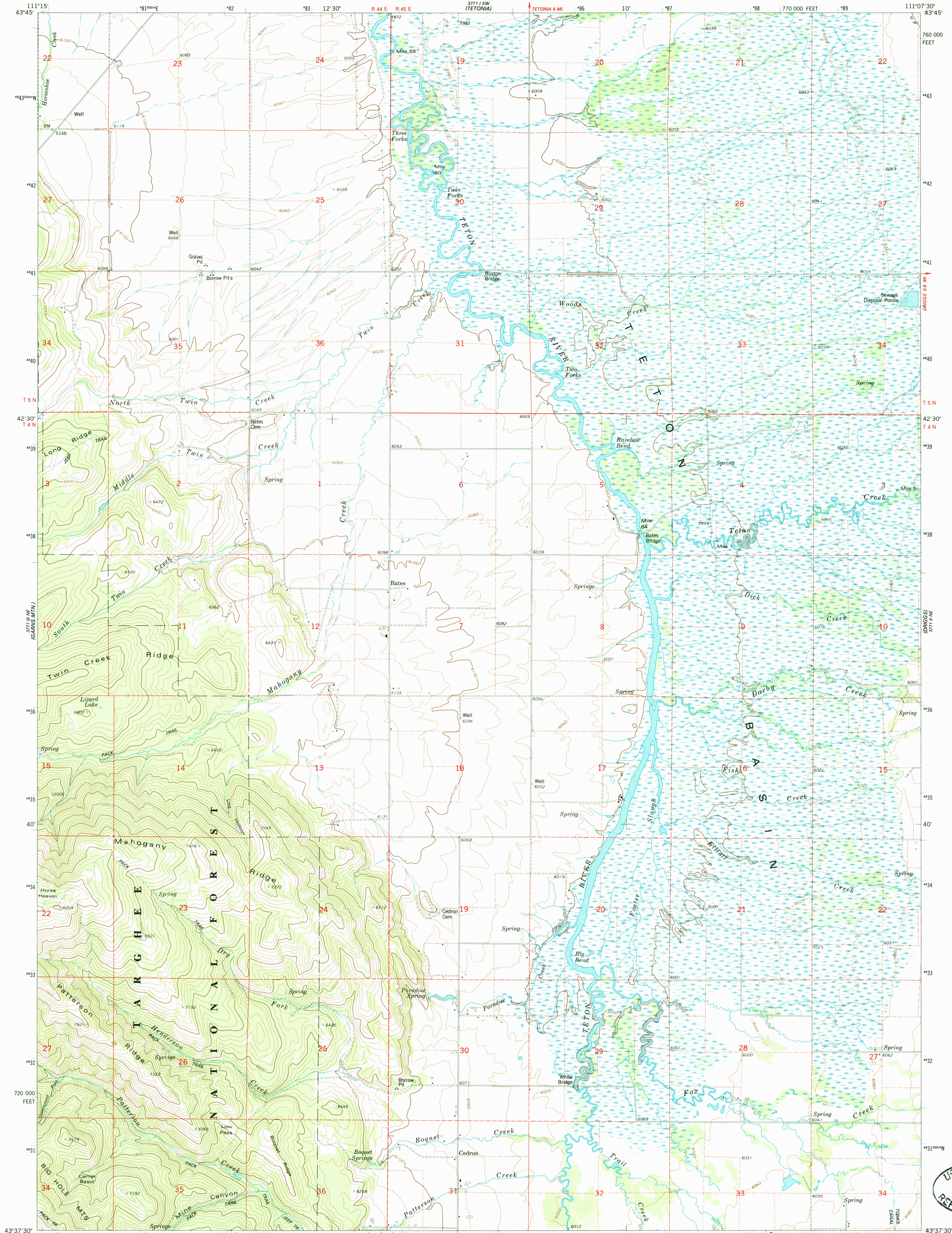

NW/4 DRIGGS 15' QUADRANGLE

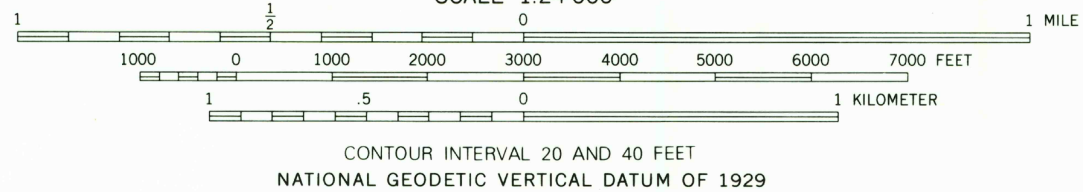
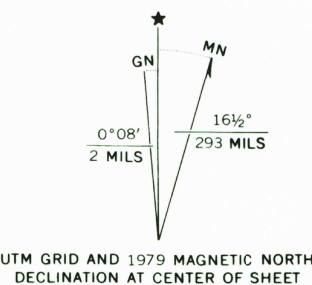

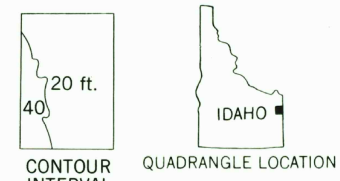
Projection and 10,000-foot grid ticks: Idaho coordinate
