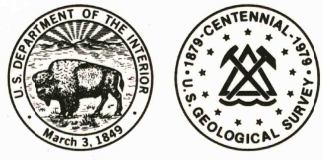
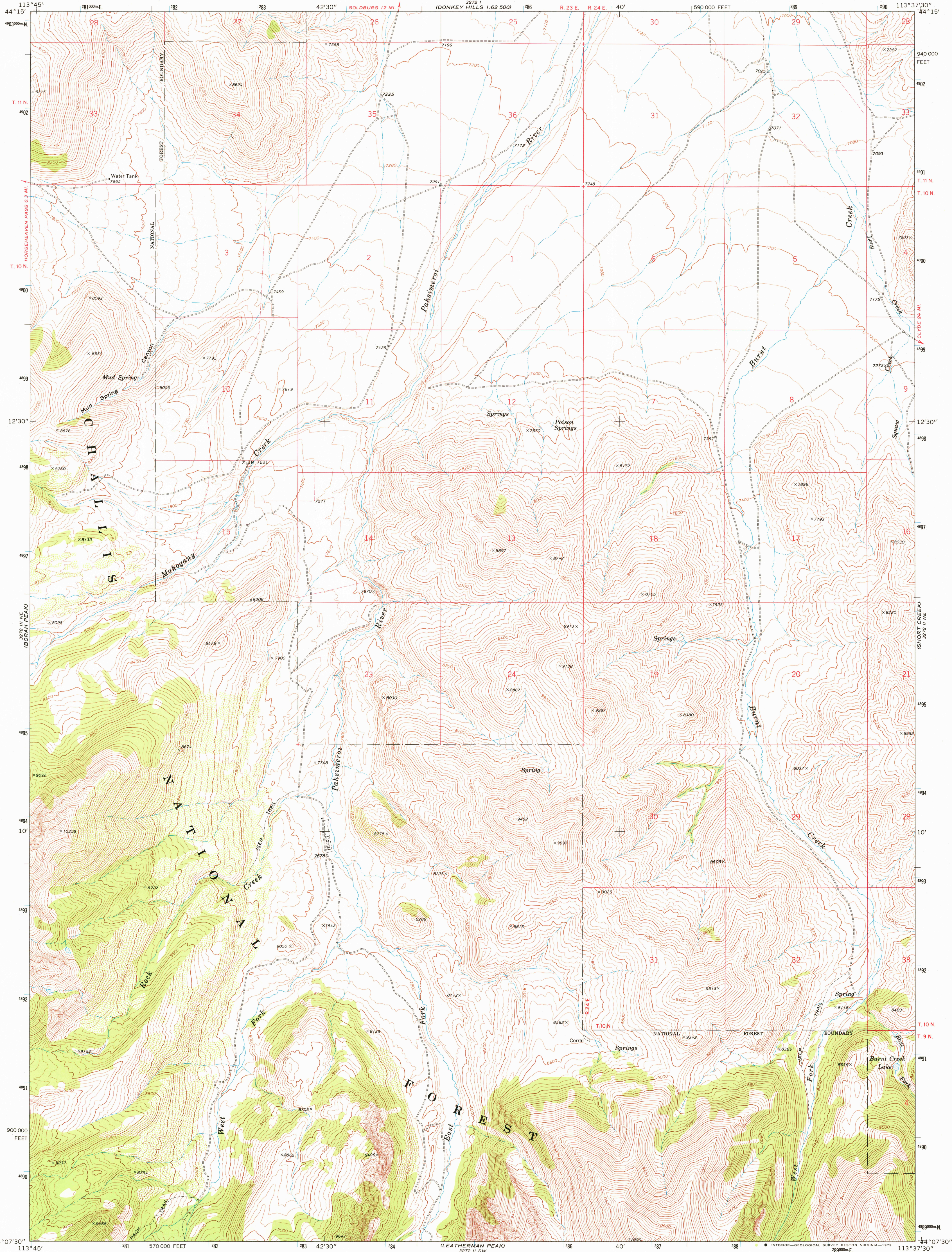

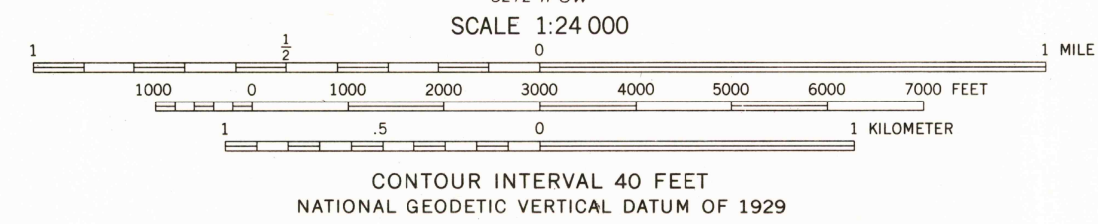
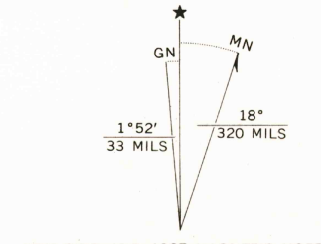
Polycyclic projection. 1927 North American datum 10,000-foot grid based on Idaho coordinate system, central zone

Fine red dashed lines indicate selected fence lines

Where omitted, land lines have not been established
