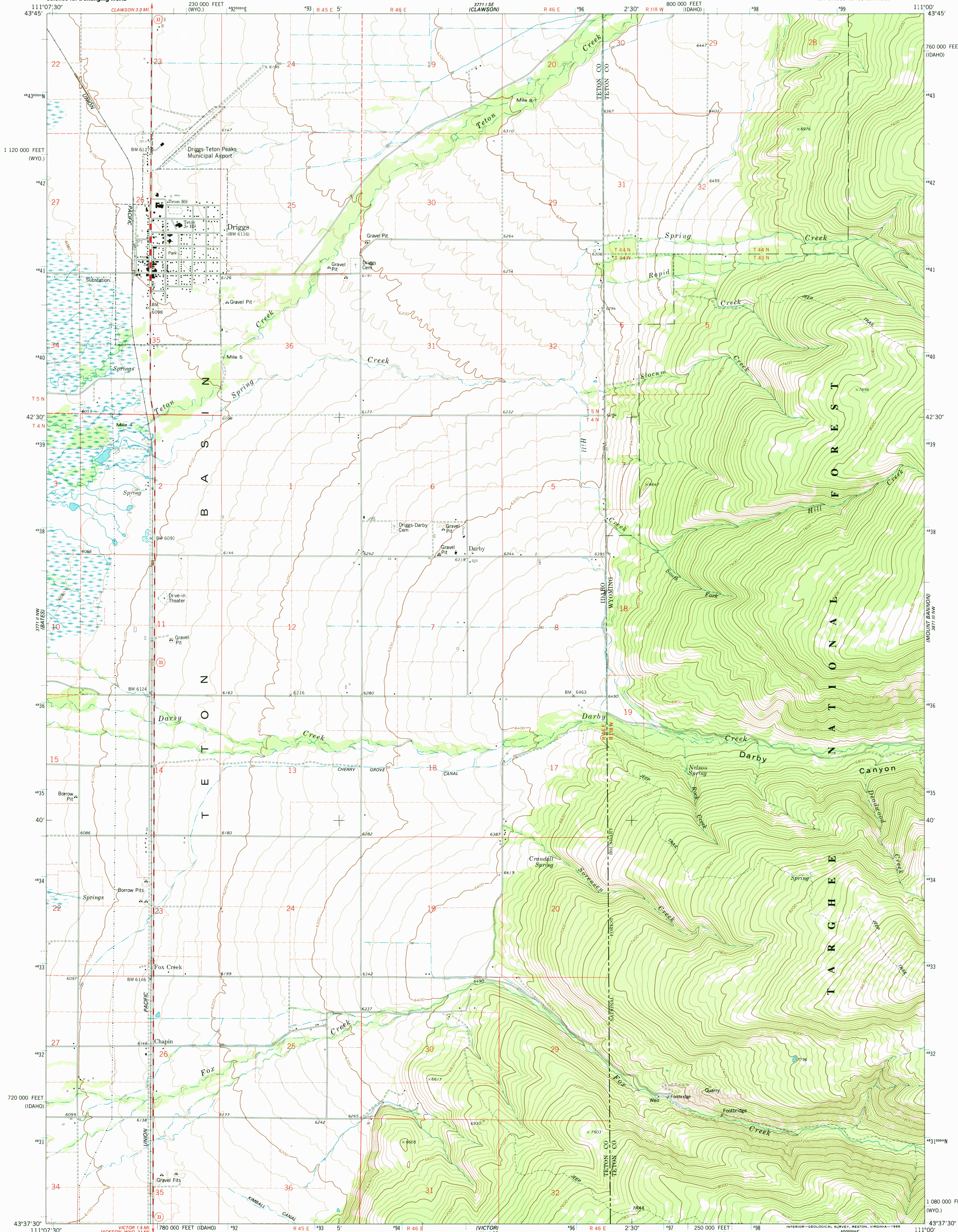


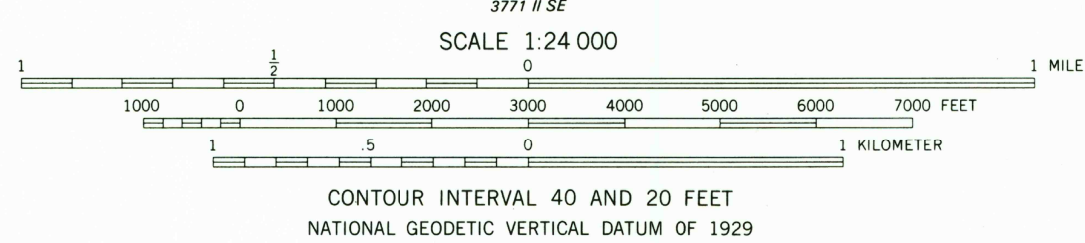
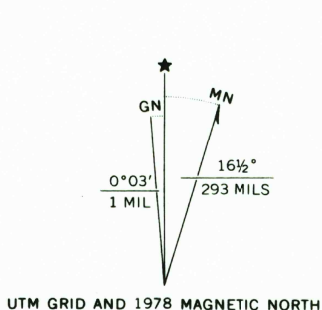


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Topography by photogrammetric methods from aerial

zone 12, shown in blue. 1927 North American datum
To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983
move the projection lines 11 meters north and
63 meters east as shown by dashed corner ticks
