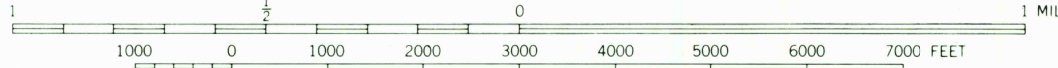
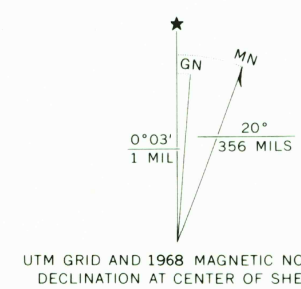

Polyconic projection. 1927 North American datum 10,000-foot grids based on Idaho coordinate system, west zone and Washington coordinate system, south zone 1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks, zone 11, shown in blue.
To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983 move the projection lines 17 meters north and 78 meters east as shown by dashed corner ticks
