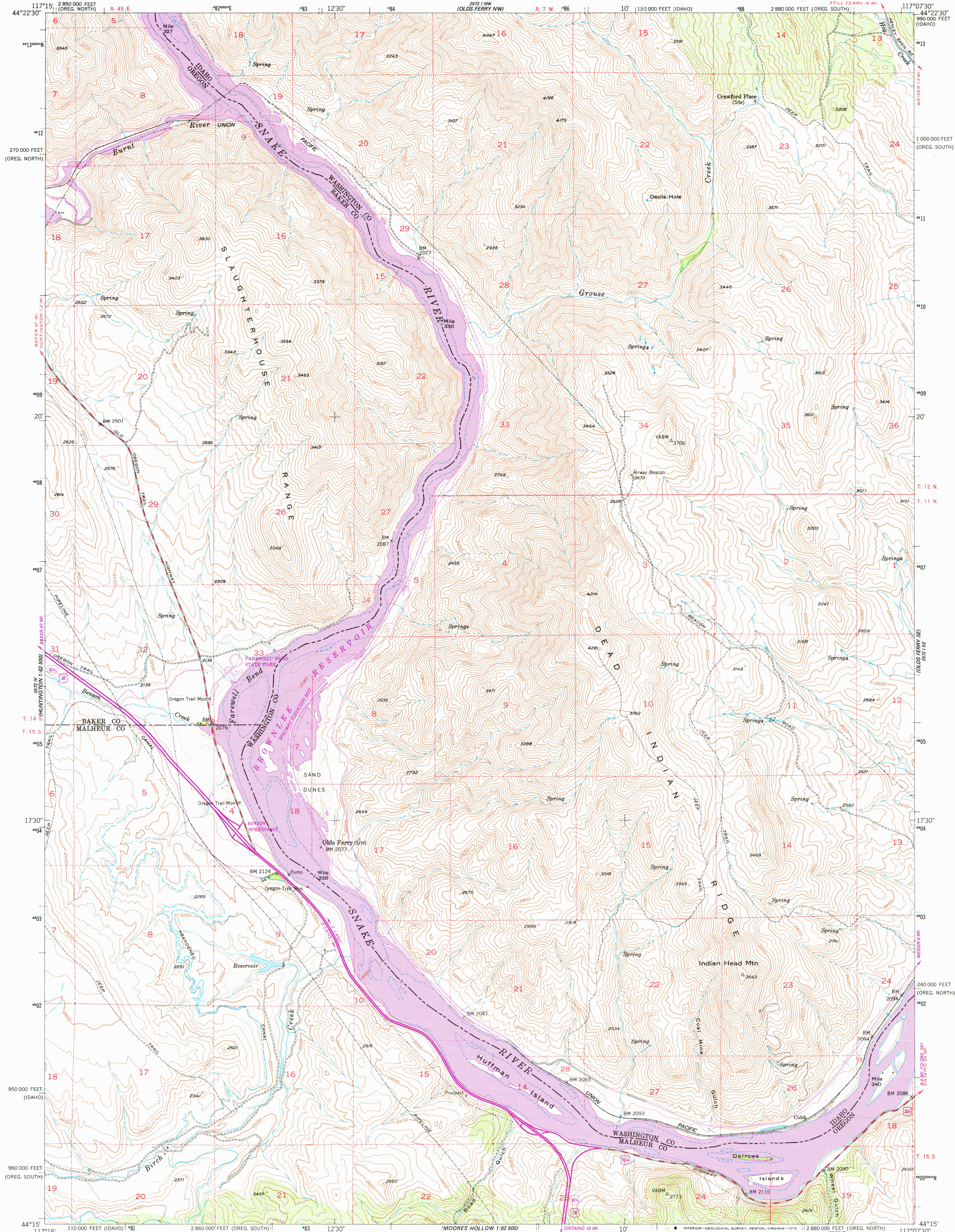

Polycyclic projection. 1927 North American datum

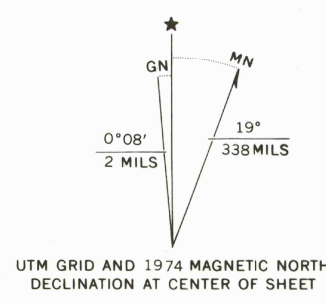
10,000-foot grids based on Idaho coordinate system, west zone
