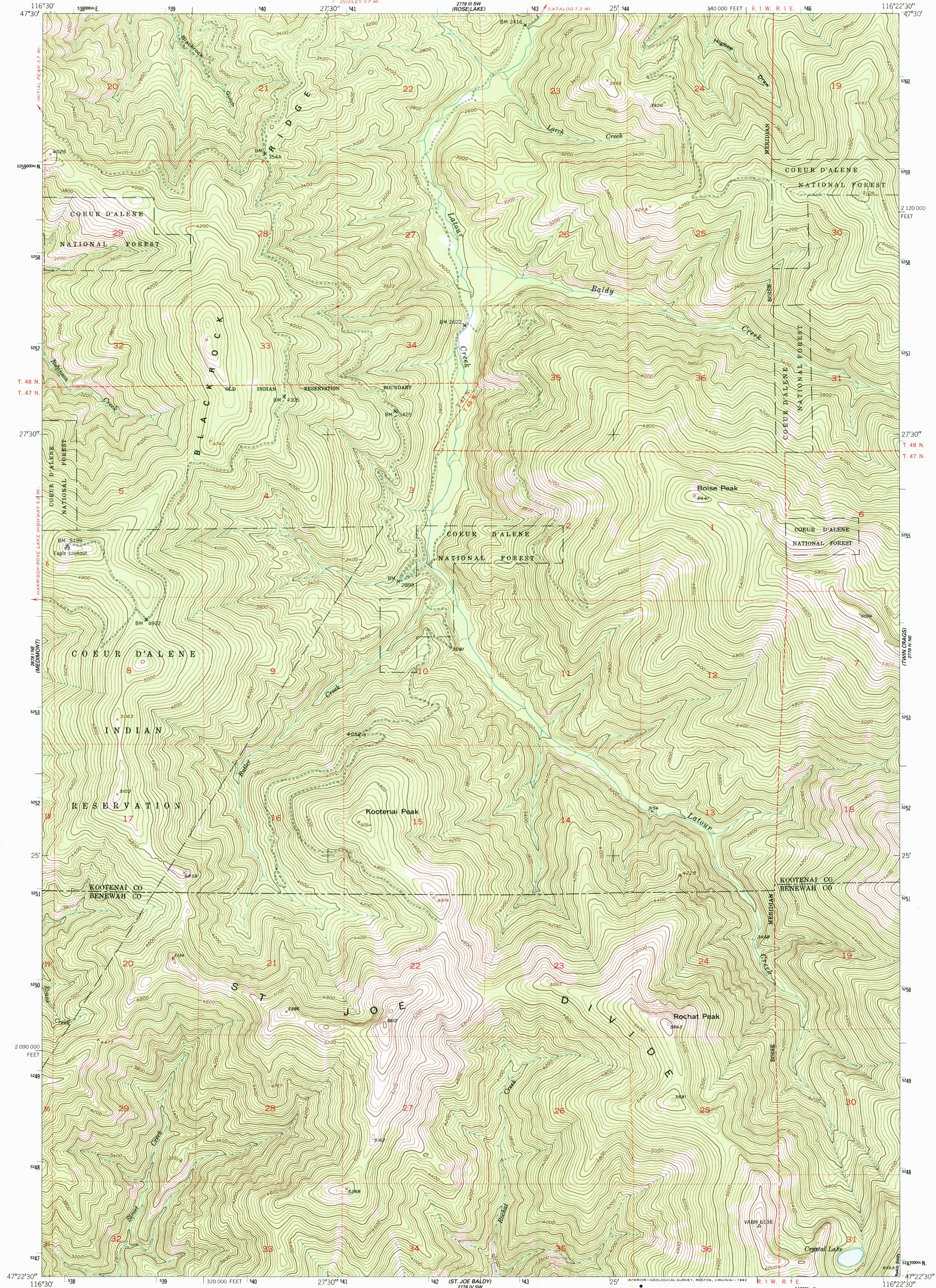

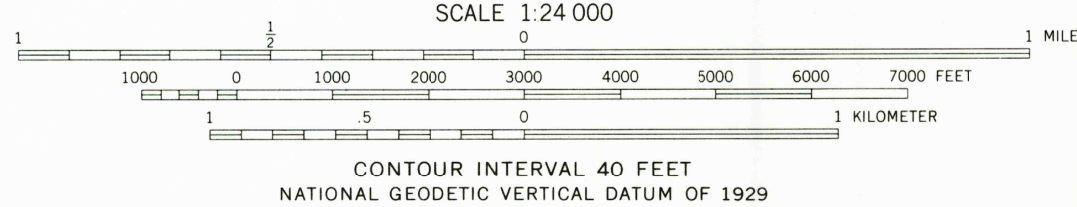
Topography from aerial photographs by multiplex methods

grid ticks, zone 11, shown in blue

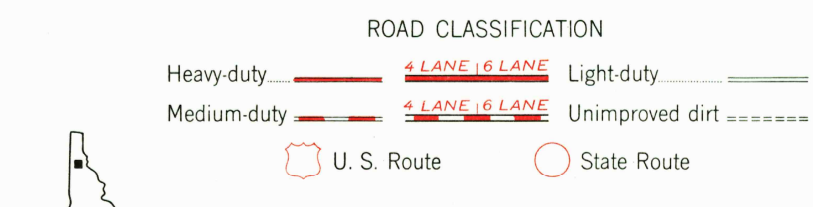
The difference between 1927 North American Datum and
