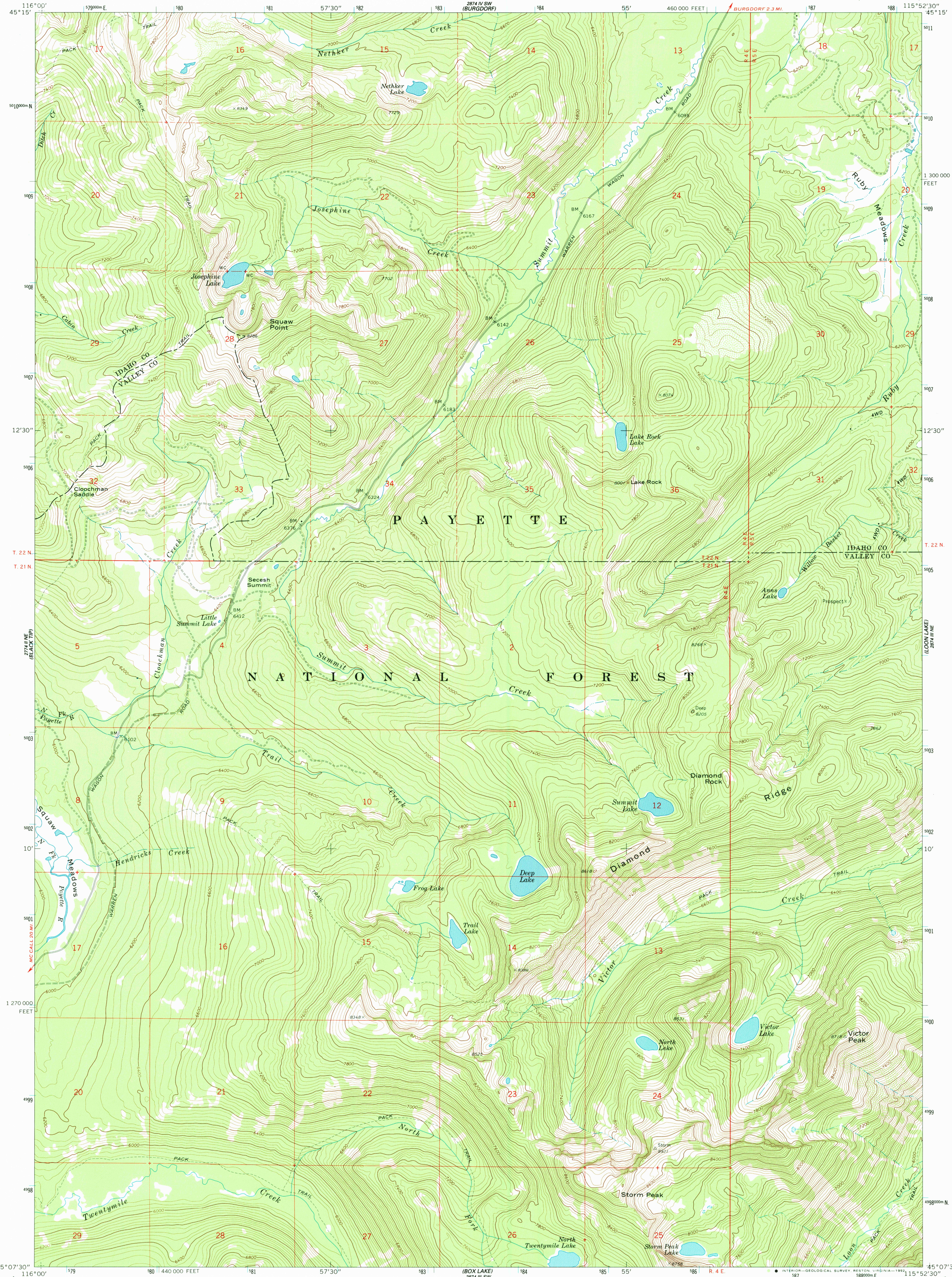

west zone

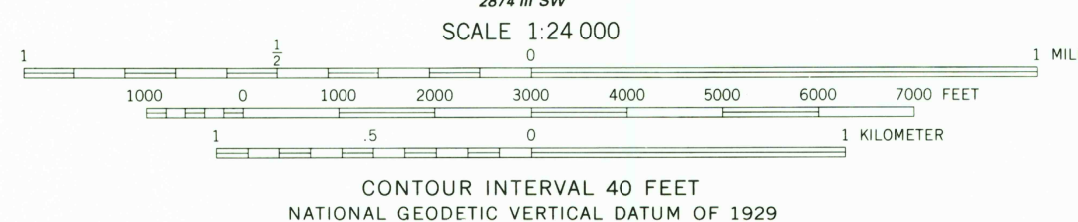
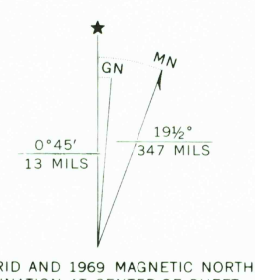
1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks, zone 11,
