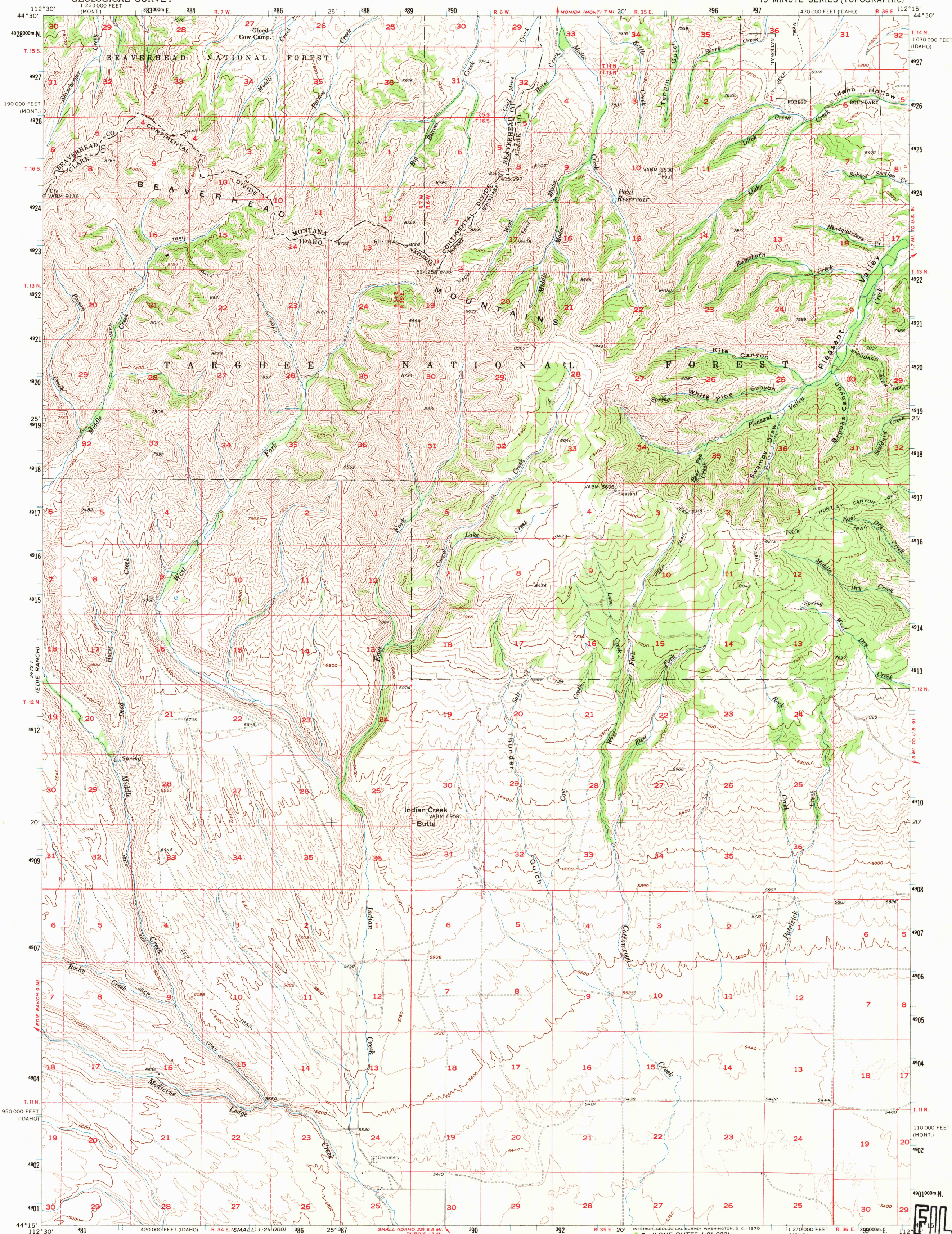

10,000-foot grids based on Idaho coordinate system,

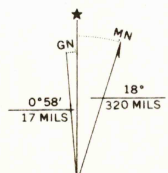
east zone, and Montana coordinate system, south zone

1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks,

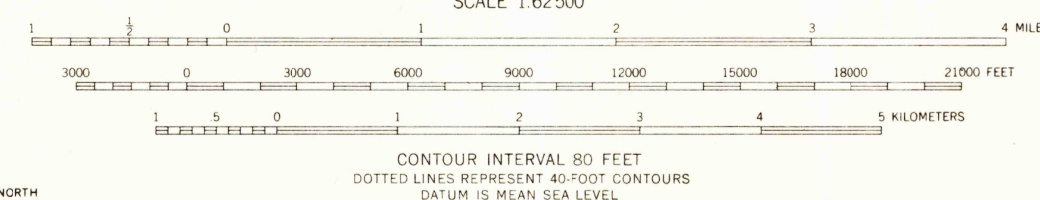
zone 12, shown in blue
