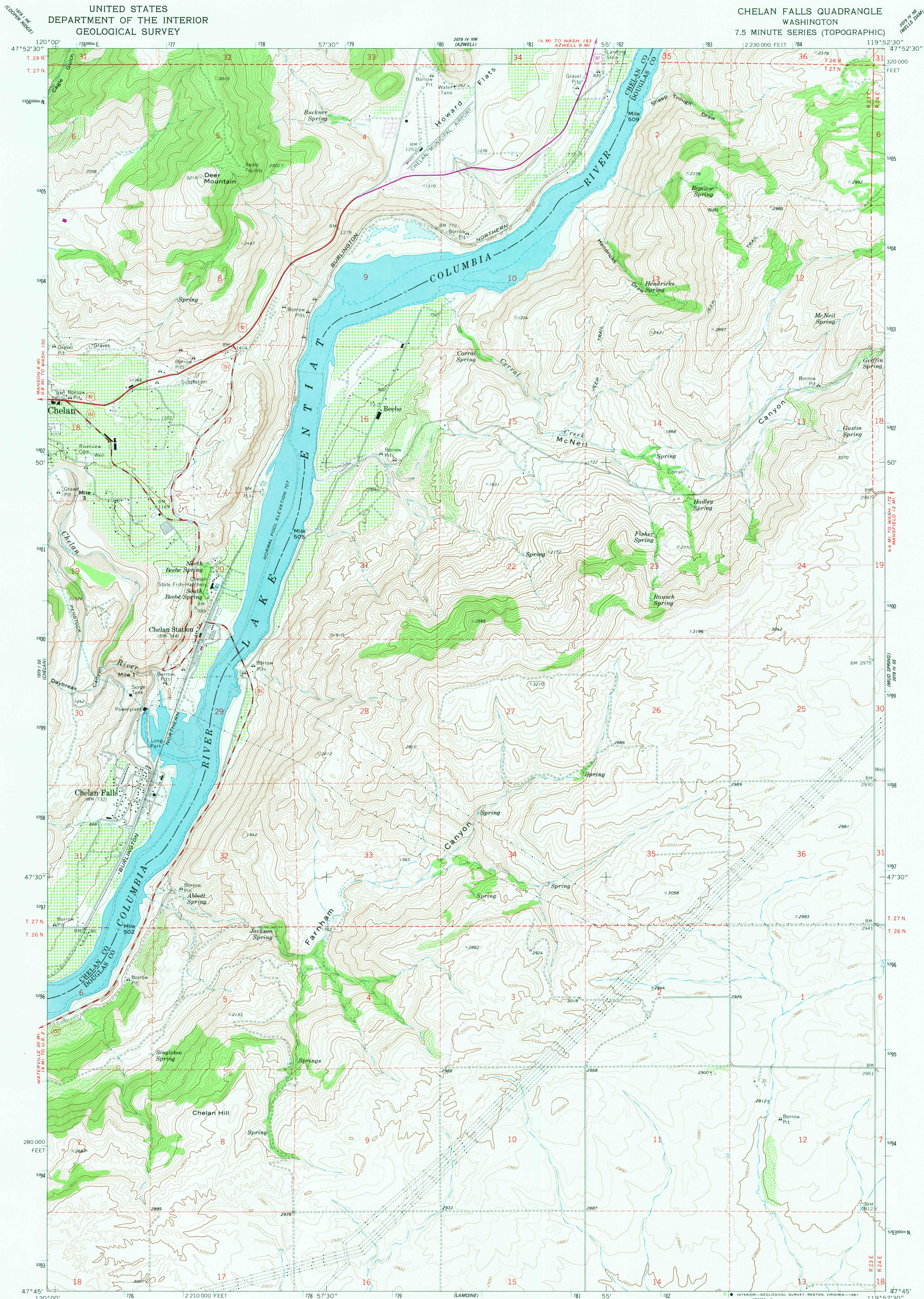

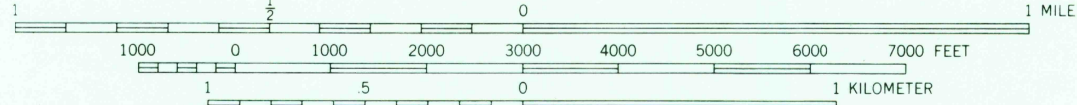
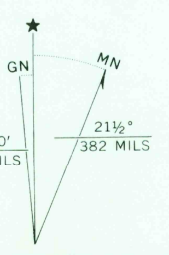
Topography by photogrammetric methods from aerial photographs taken 1967. Field checked 1968

1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks, zone 11, shown in blue

To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983, move the projection lines 19 meters north and 87 meters east as shown by dashed corner ticks

Fine red dashed lines indicate selected fence lines
