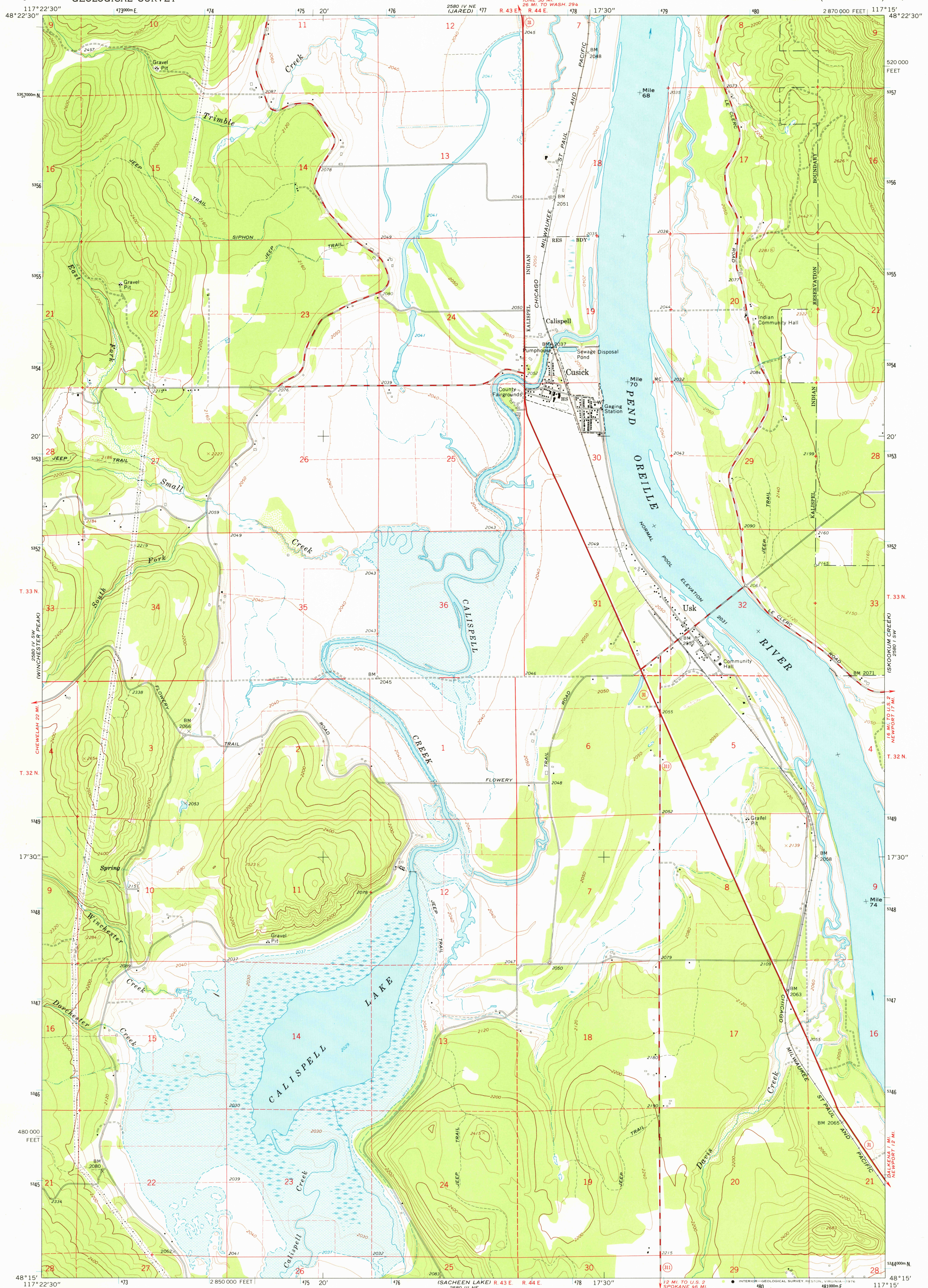

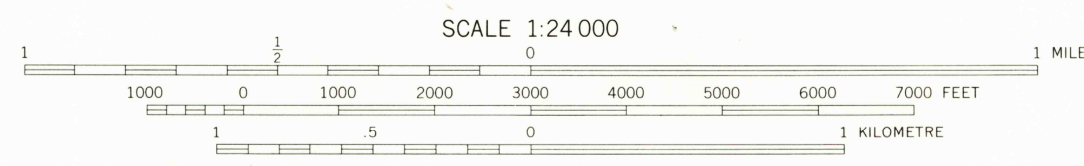
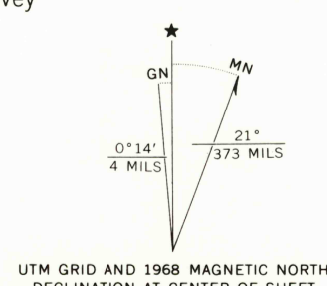
1000-metre Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks,
