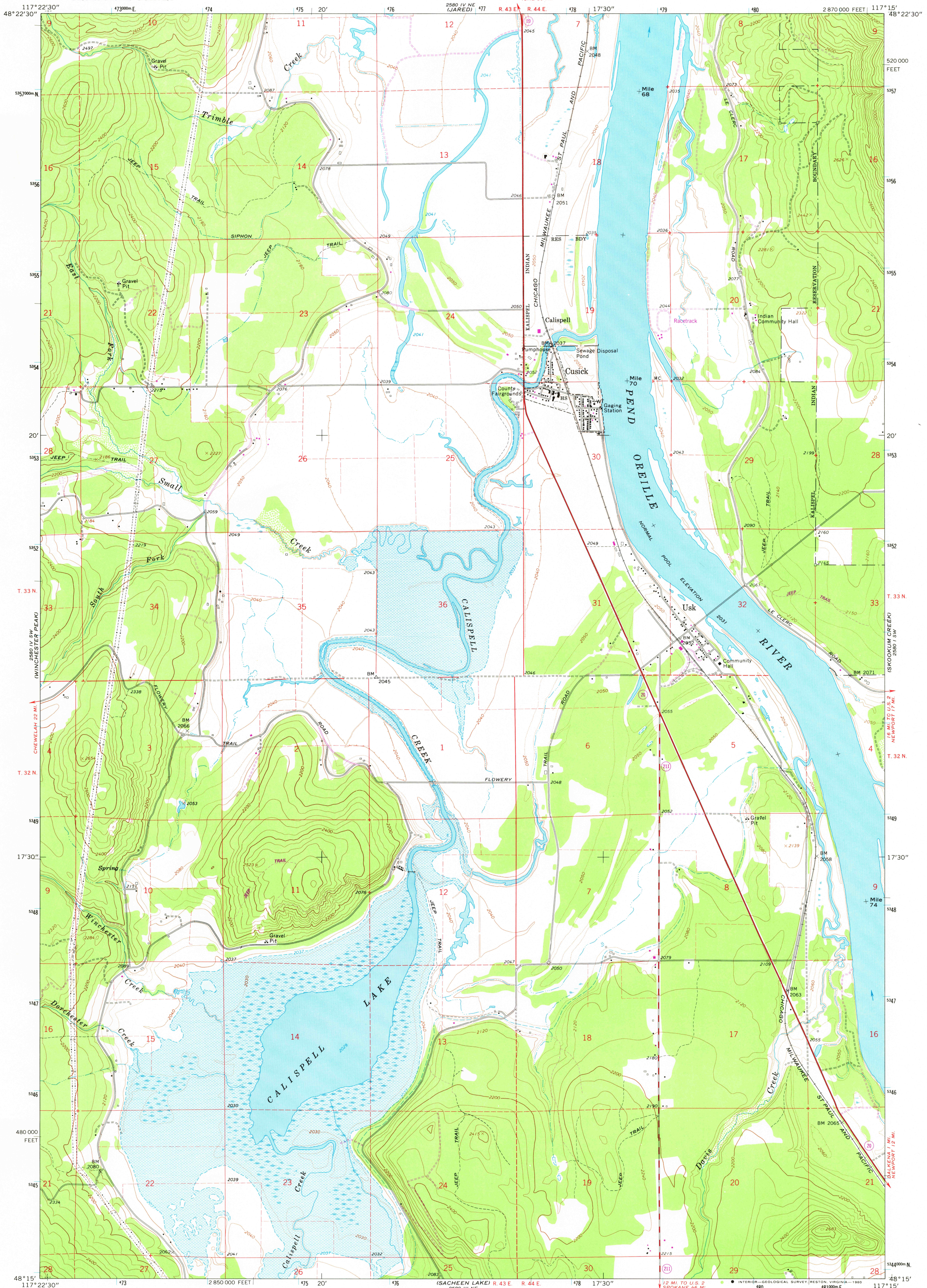

move the projection lines 14 meters north and

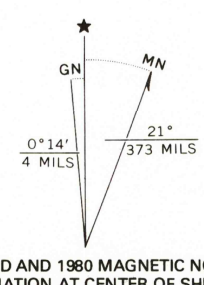
79 meters east as shown by dashed corner ticks
