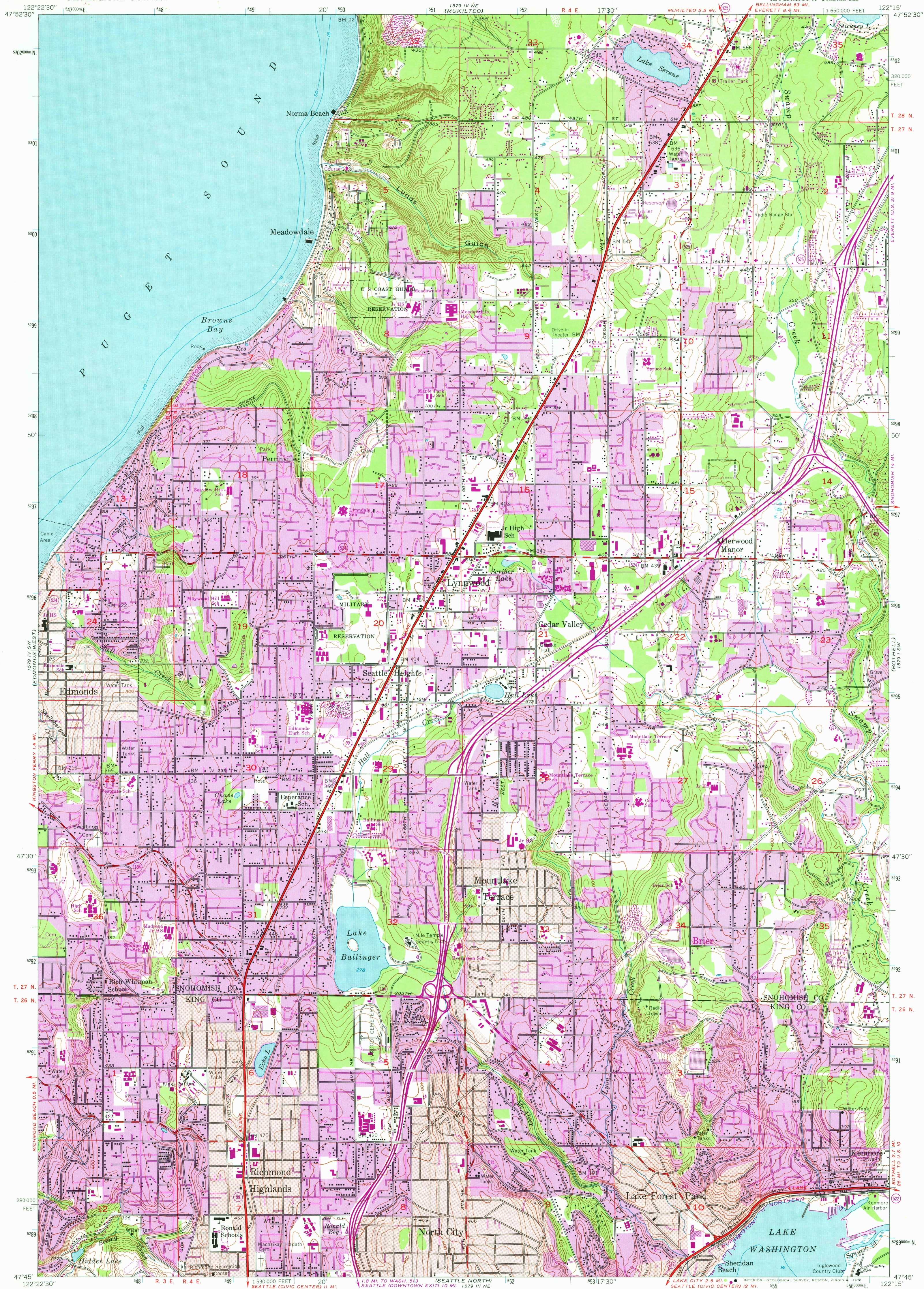

DEPTH CURVES IN FEET-DATUM IS MEAN LOWER LOW WATER

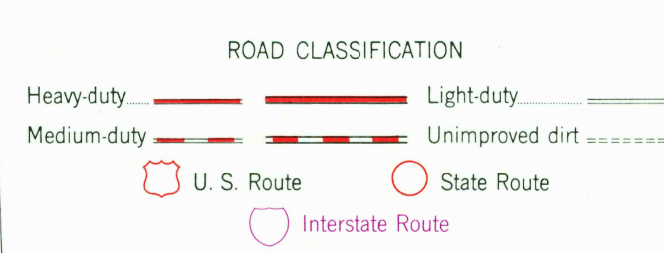
SHORELINE SHOWN REPRESENTS THE APPROXIMATE LINE OF MEAN HIGH WATER
