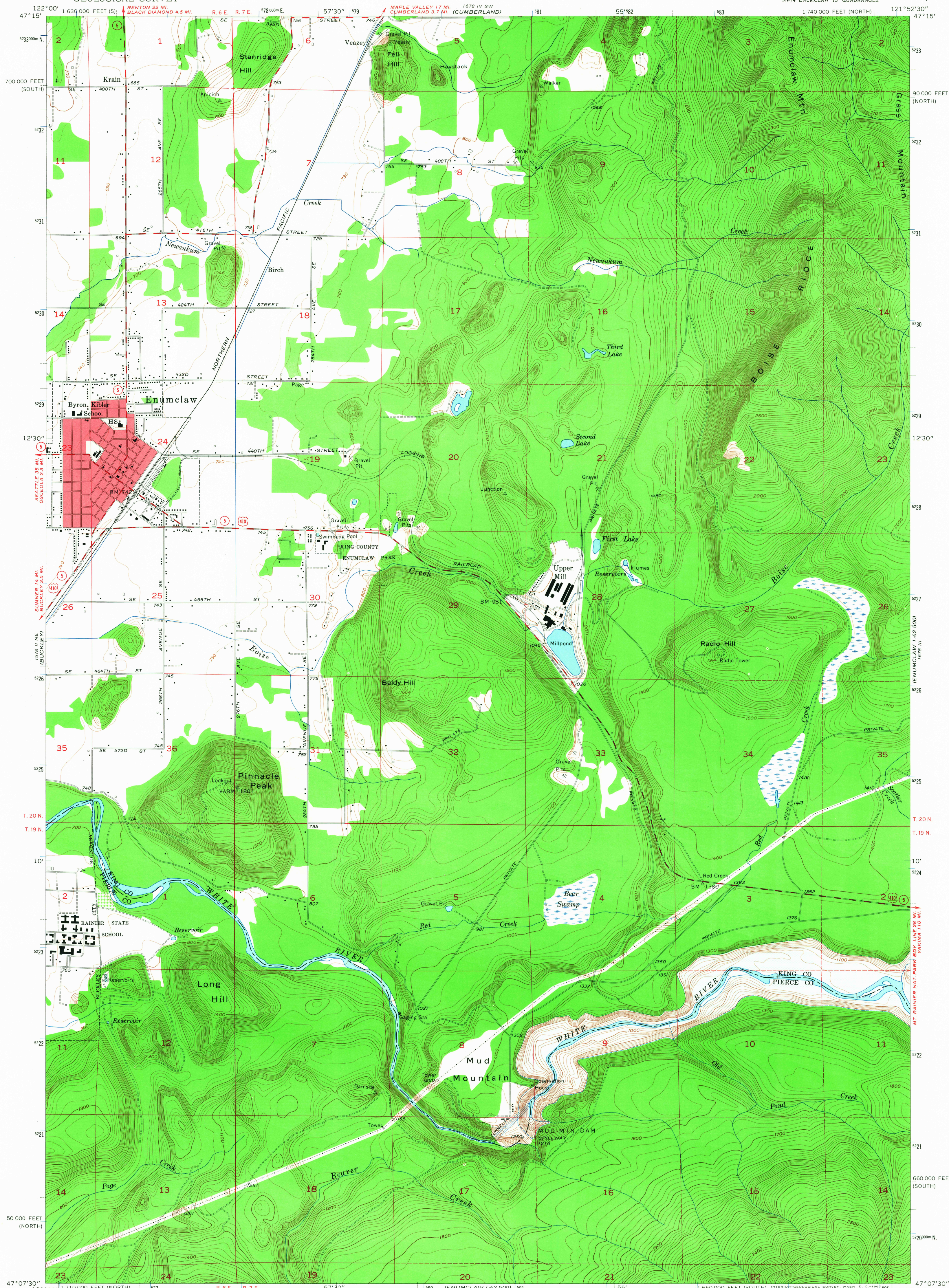

Red tint indicates areas in which only

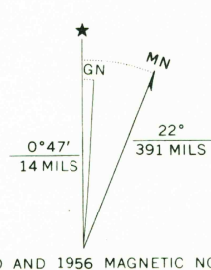
landmark buildings are shown

Dashed land lines indicate approximate locations

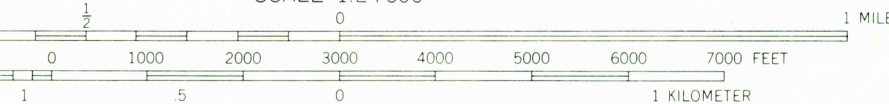
Unchecked elevations are shown in brown
