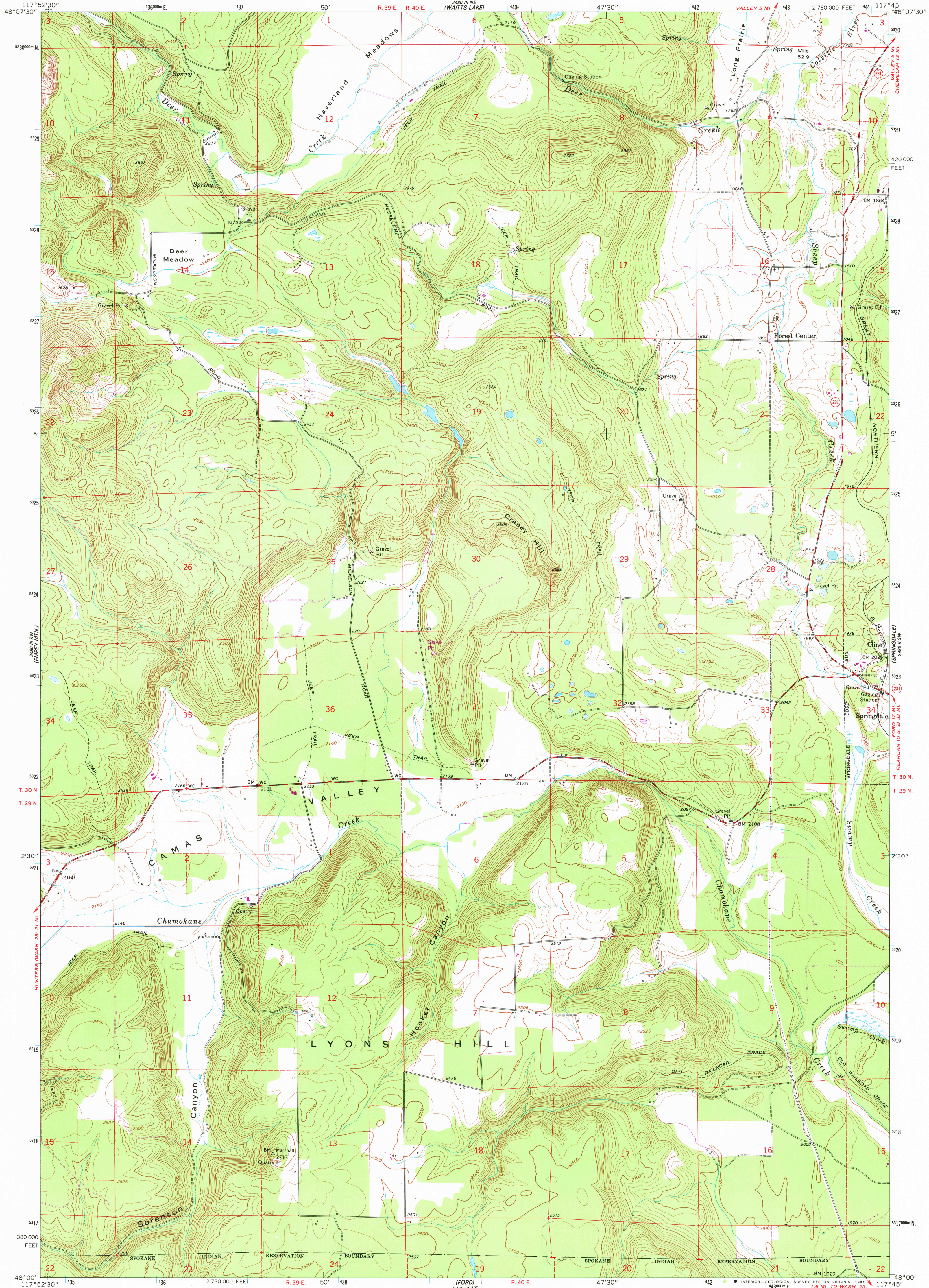

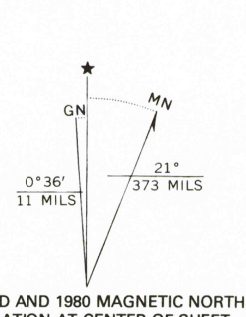
Polycyclic projection. 1927 North American datum 10,000-foot grid based on Washington coordinate system, north zone
