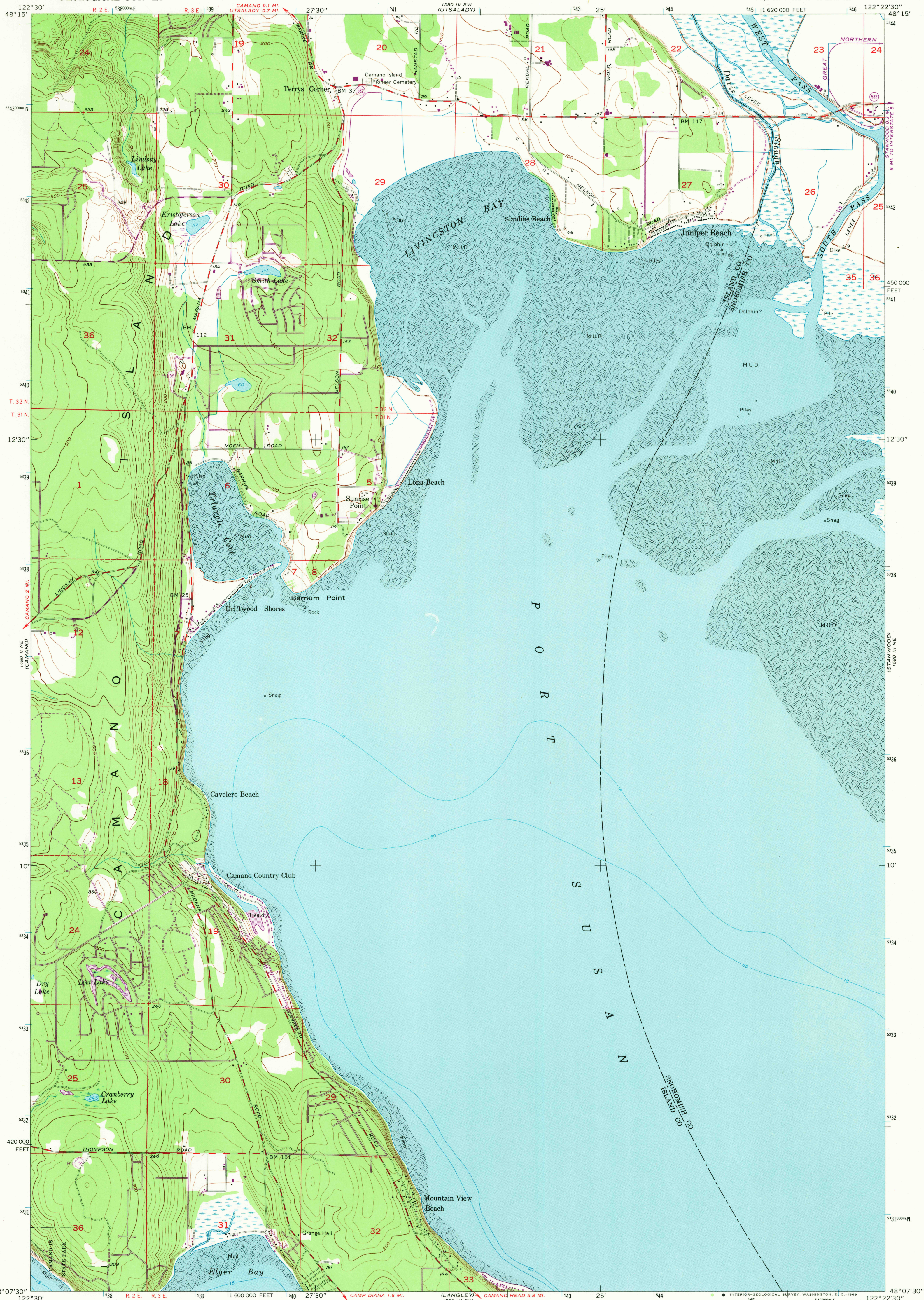

THE AVERAGE RANGE OF TIDE IS APPROXIMATELY 7 FEET

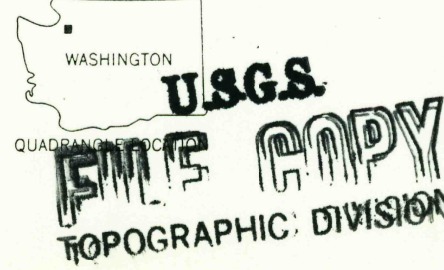
