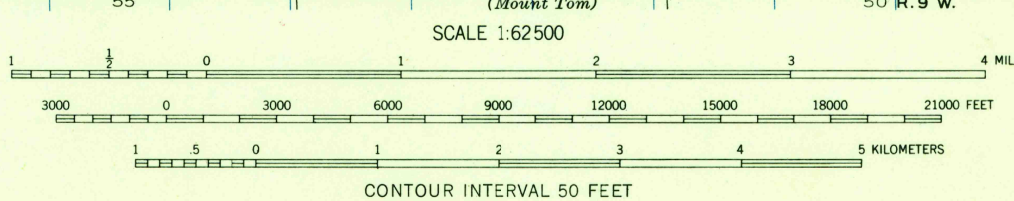

zone 10, shown in blue
Shore line is the margin of water at mean high tide
Height of mean higher high tide at Gettysburg
is 8 feet above mean lower low water
