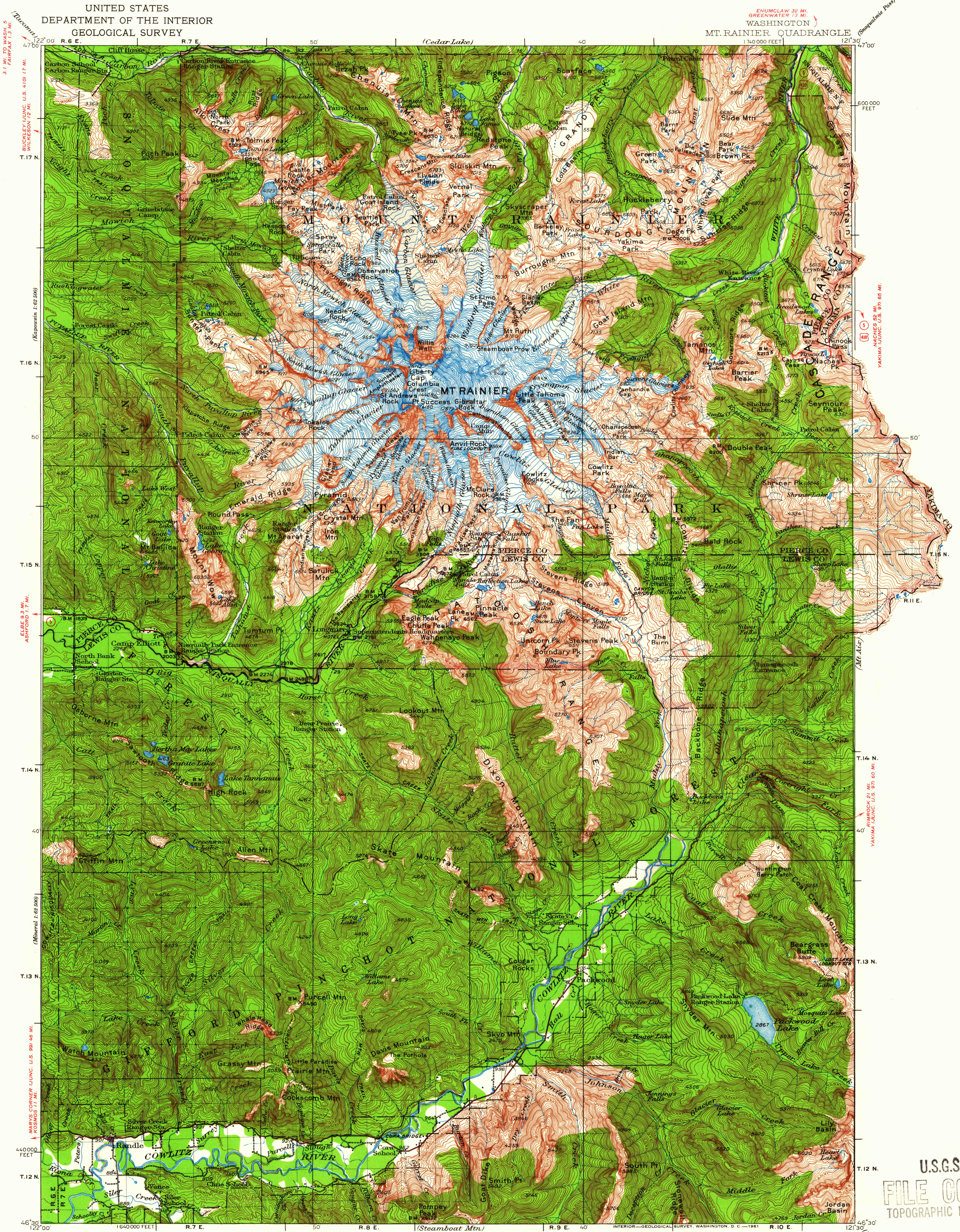

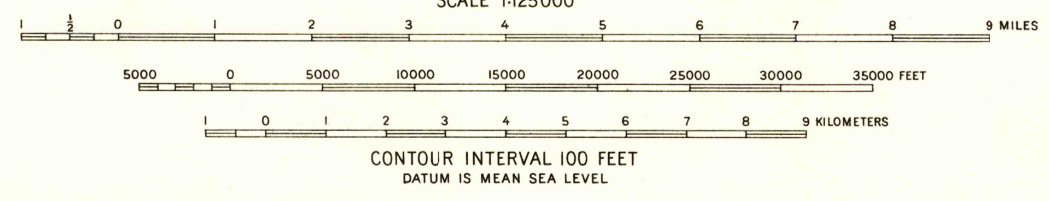
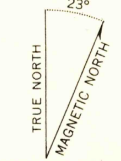
WASHINGTON
