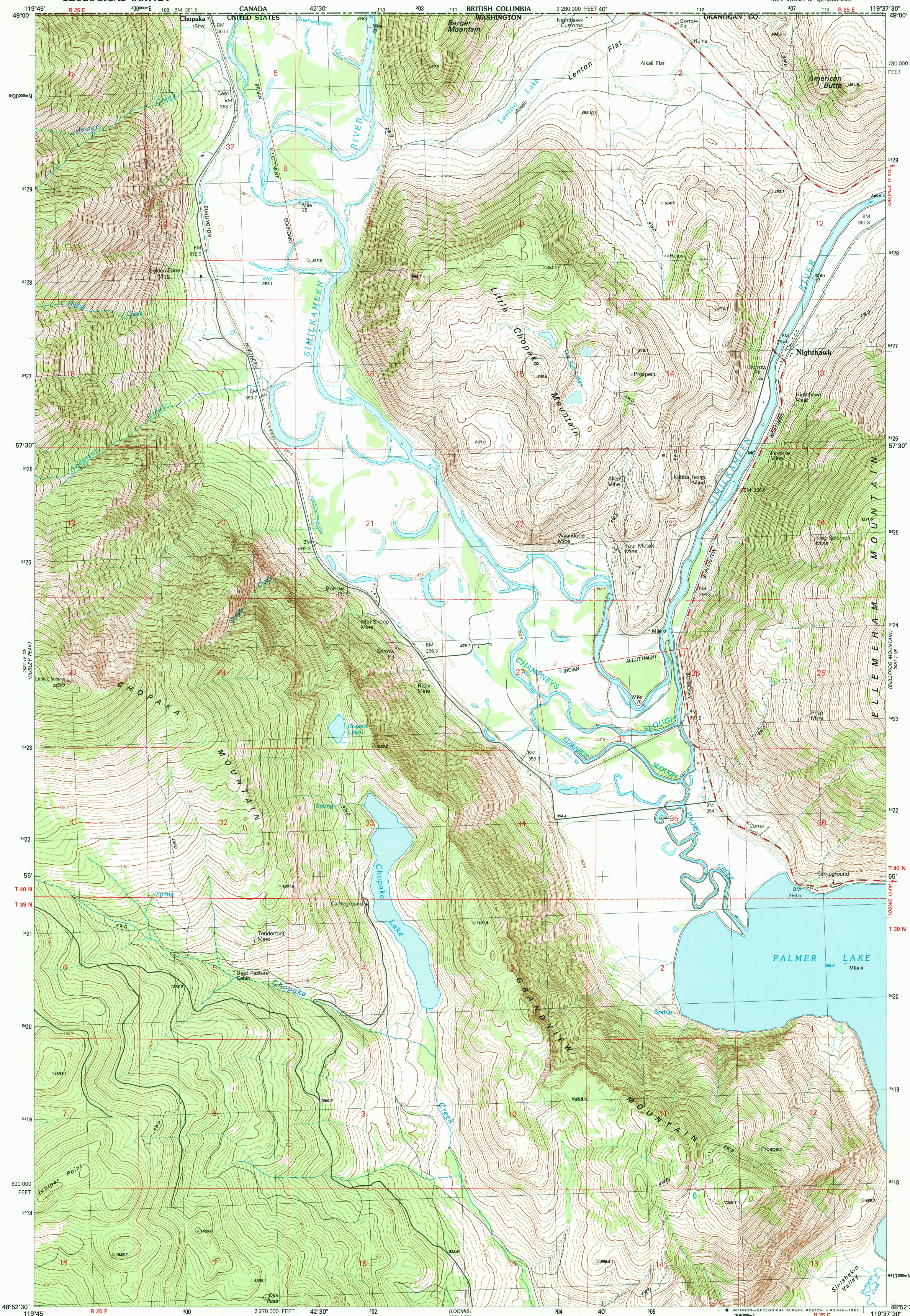

To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983 move the projection lines 19 meters north and

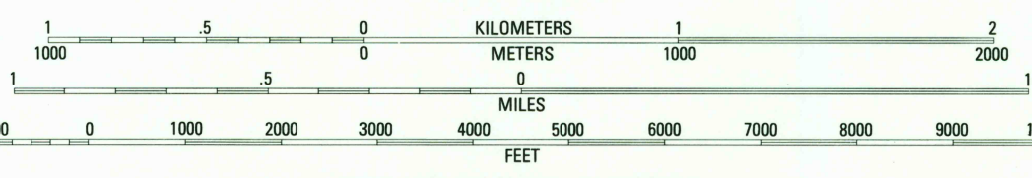
86 meters east as shown by dashed corner ticks
