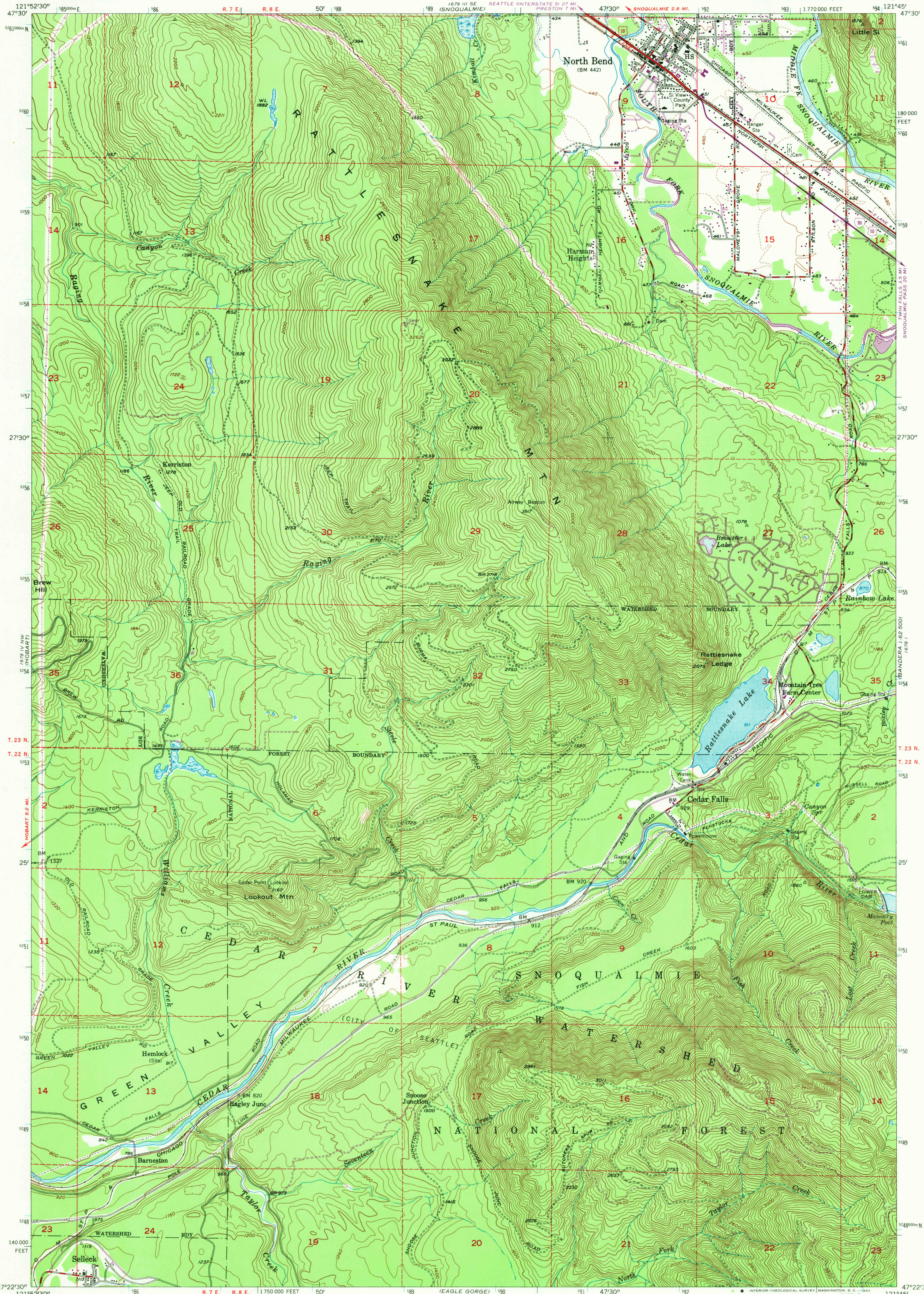

10,000-foot grid based on Washington coordinate system, north zone

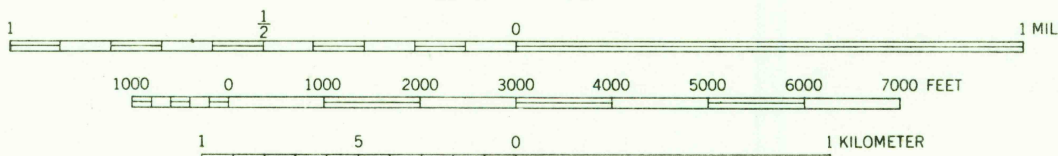
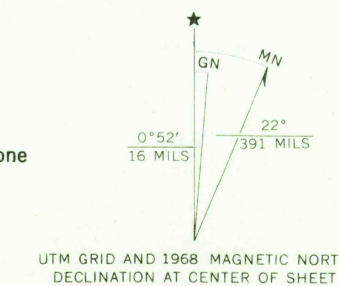
Travel within the Cedar River Watershed area is restricted
