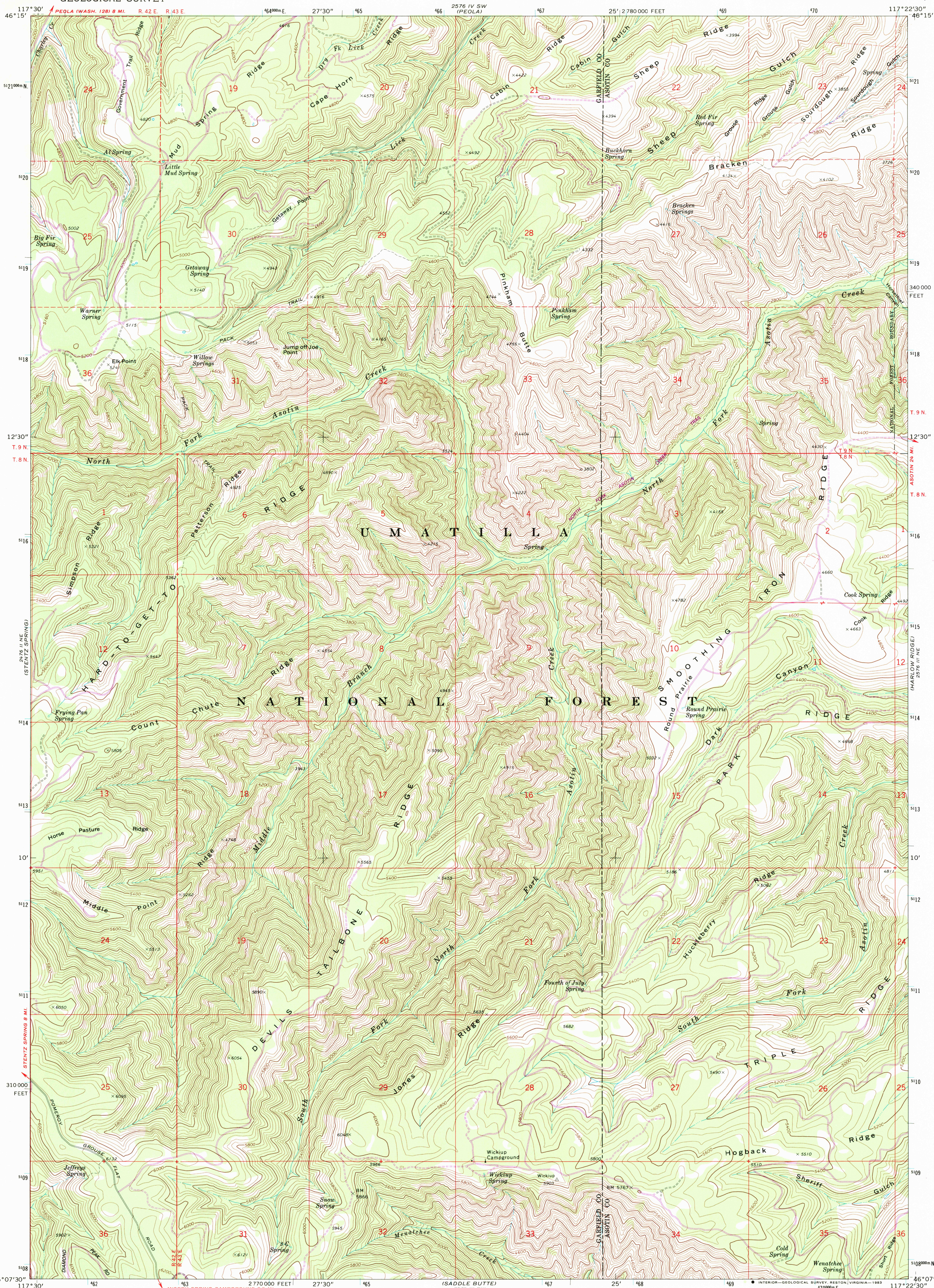

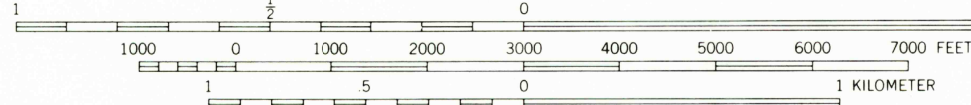
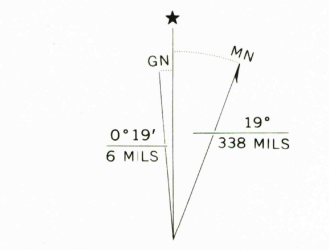
Topography by photogrammetric methods from aerial photographs taken 1970. Field checked 1971

Projection and 10,000-foot grid ticks: Washington coordinate system, south zone (Lambert conformal conic), 1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks, zone 11, shown in blue. 1927 North American datum

Fine red dashed lines indicate selected fence lines

To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983 move the projection lines 17 meters north and 79 meters east as shown by dashed corner ticks
