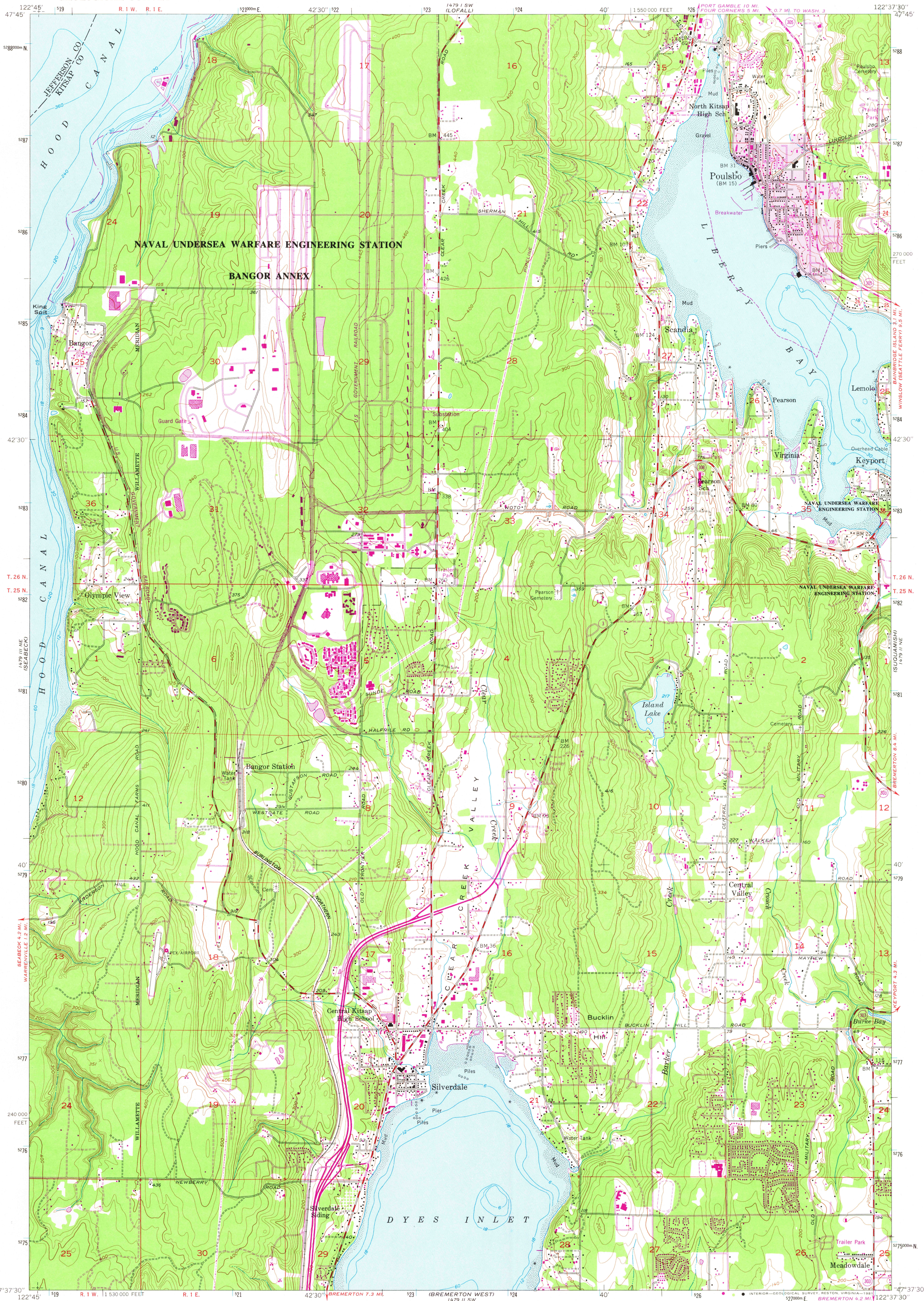

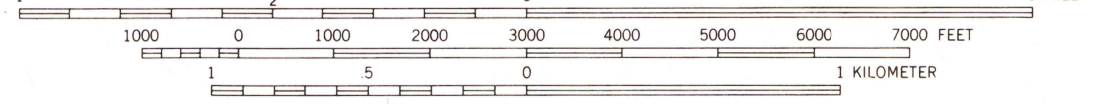
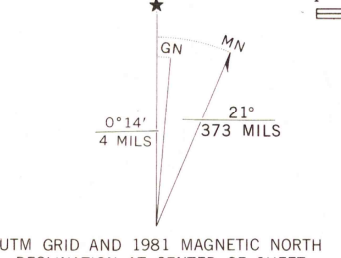

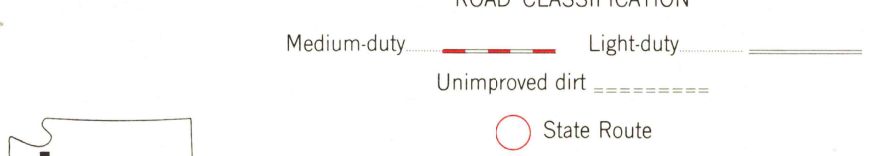
Polyconic projection. 10,000-foot grid ticks based on

DEPTH CURVES IN FEET—DATUM IS MEAN LOWER LOW WATER
THE RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN THE TWO DATUMS IS VARIABLE
SHORELINE SHOWN REPRESENTS THE APPROXIMATE LINE OF MEAN HIGH WATER
THE AVERAGE RANGE OF TIDE IS APPROXIMATELY 7 FEET IN HOOD CANAL
AND 8 FEET IN LIBERTY BAY AND DYES INLET
