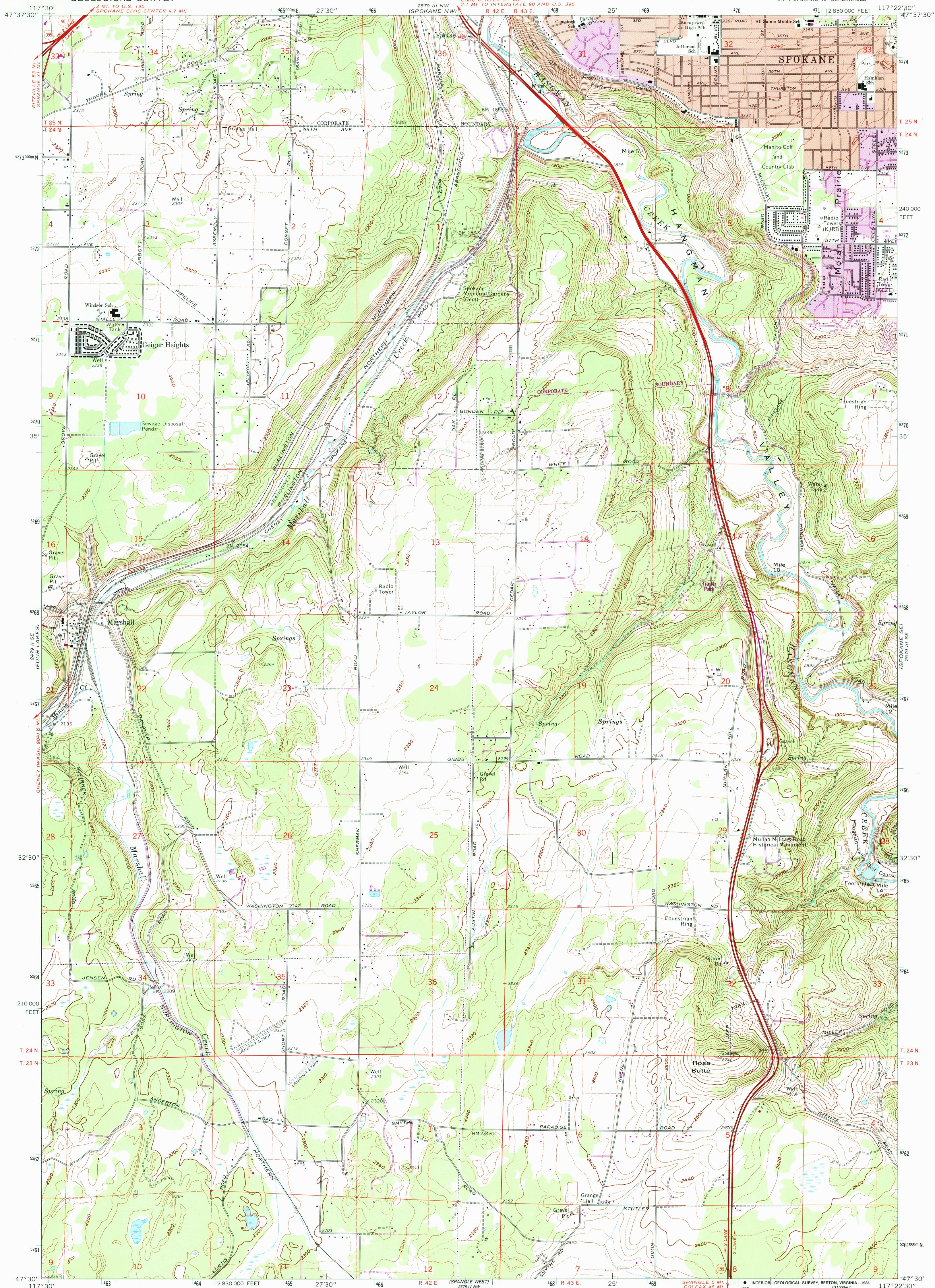

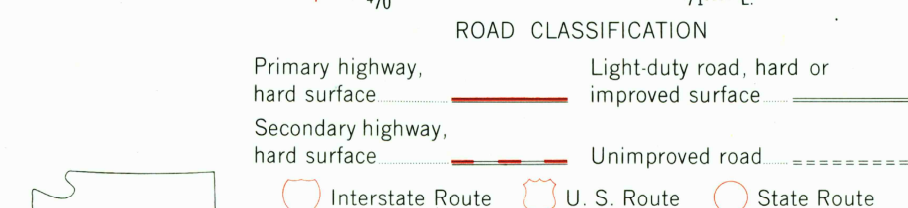
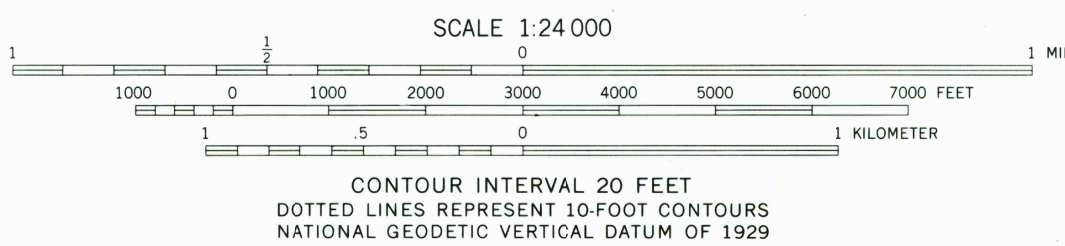
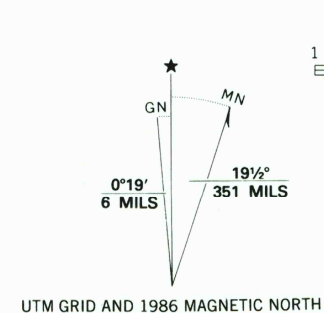

Projection and 10,000-foot grid ticks: Washington coordinate system, north zone (Lambert conformal conic, zone 11, shown in blue, 1927 North American datum). To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983 move the projection lines 15 meters north and 80 meters east as shown by dashed corner ticks. Red tint indicates area in which only landmark buildings are shown. Fine red dashed lines indicate selected fence lines.
