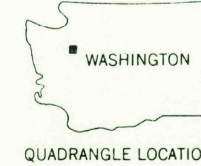

DATUM IS MEAN SEA LEVEL

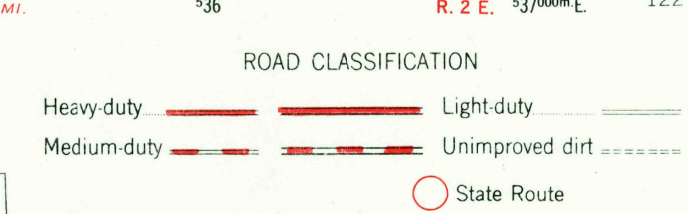
DEPTH CURVES IN FEET—DATUM IS MEAN LOWER LOW WATER
