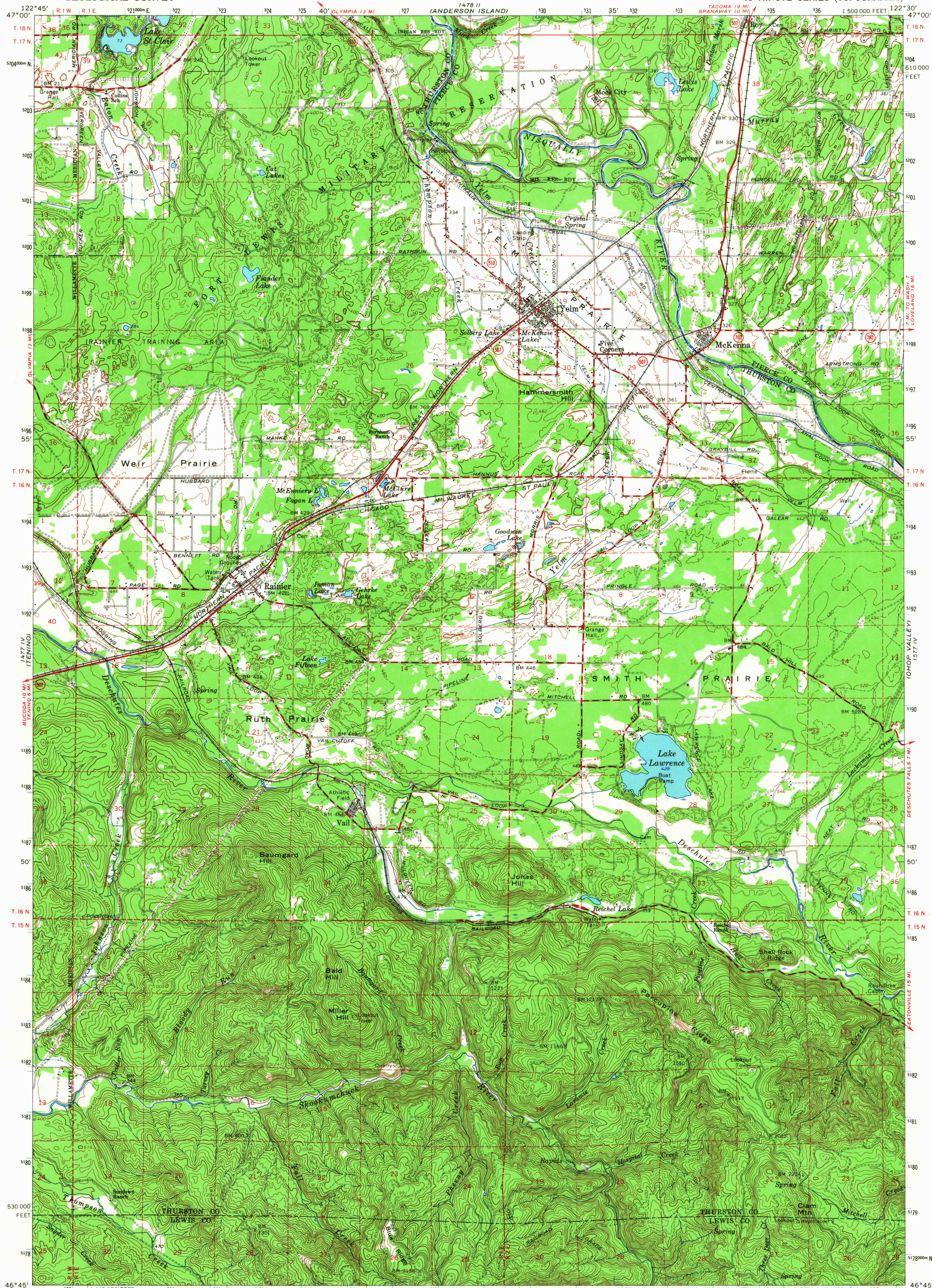

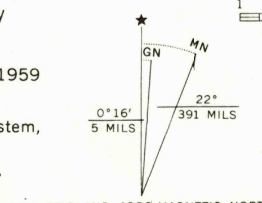
YELM QUADRANGLE
