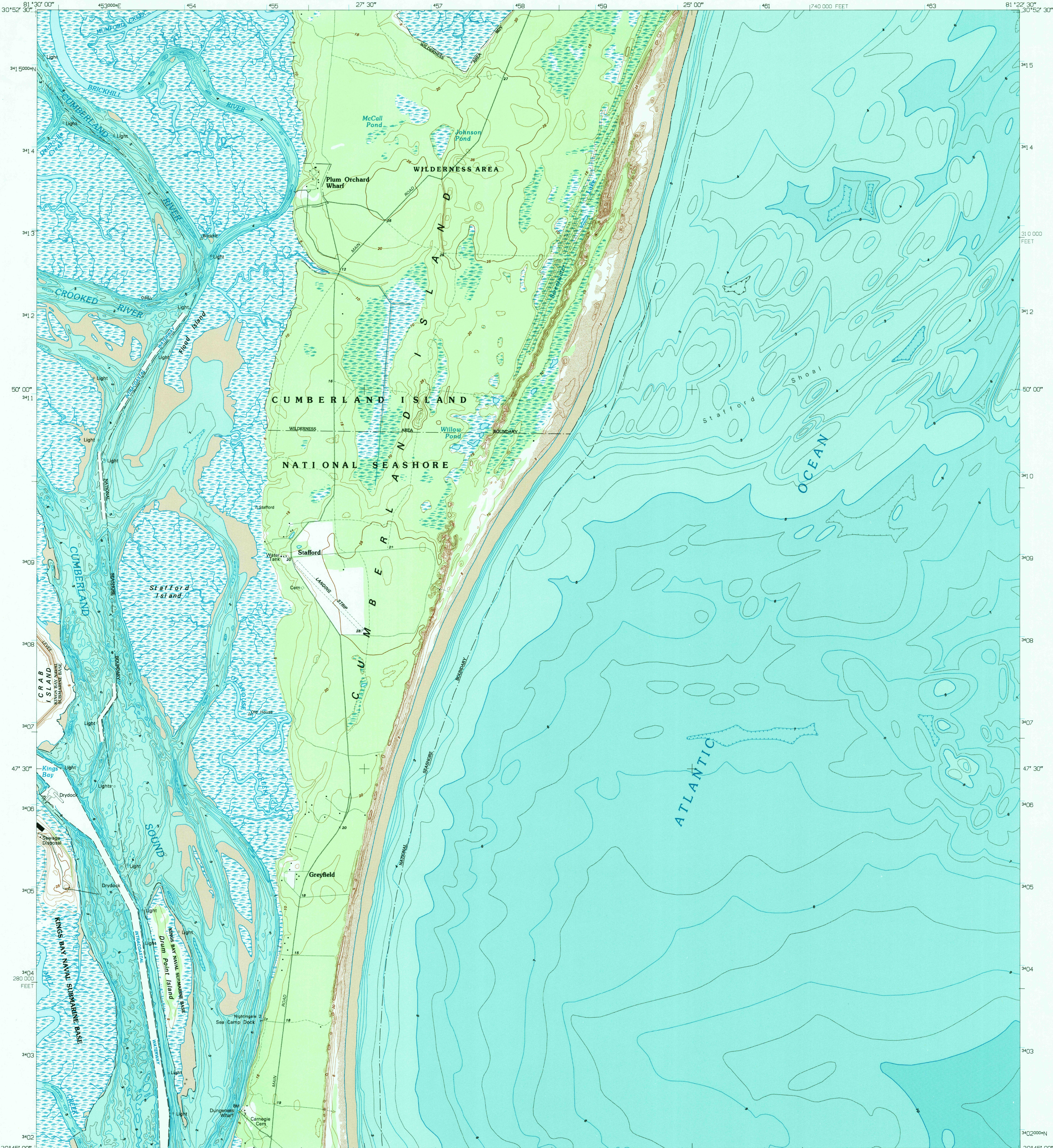
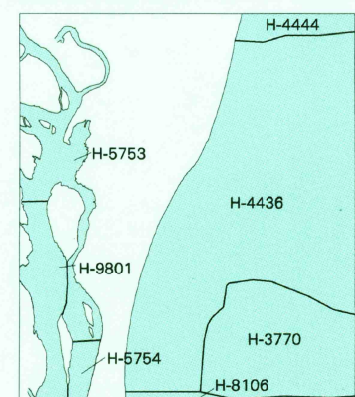


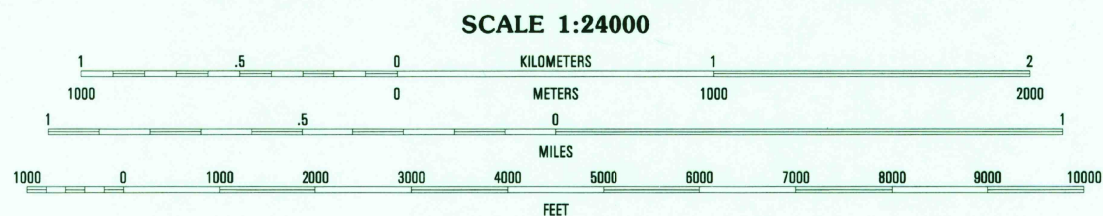

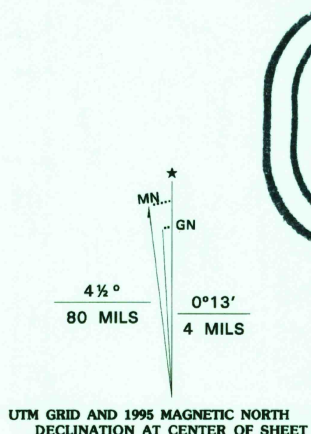


CONTOUR INTERVAL 5 FEET

THE RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN THE TWO DATUMS IS VARIABLE

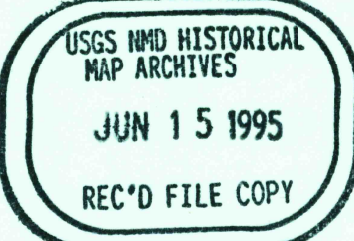
