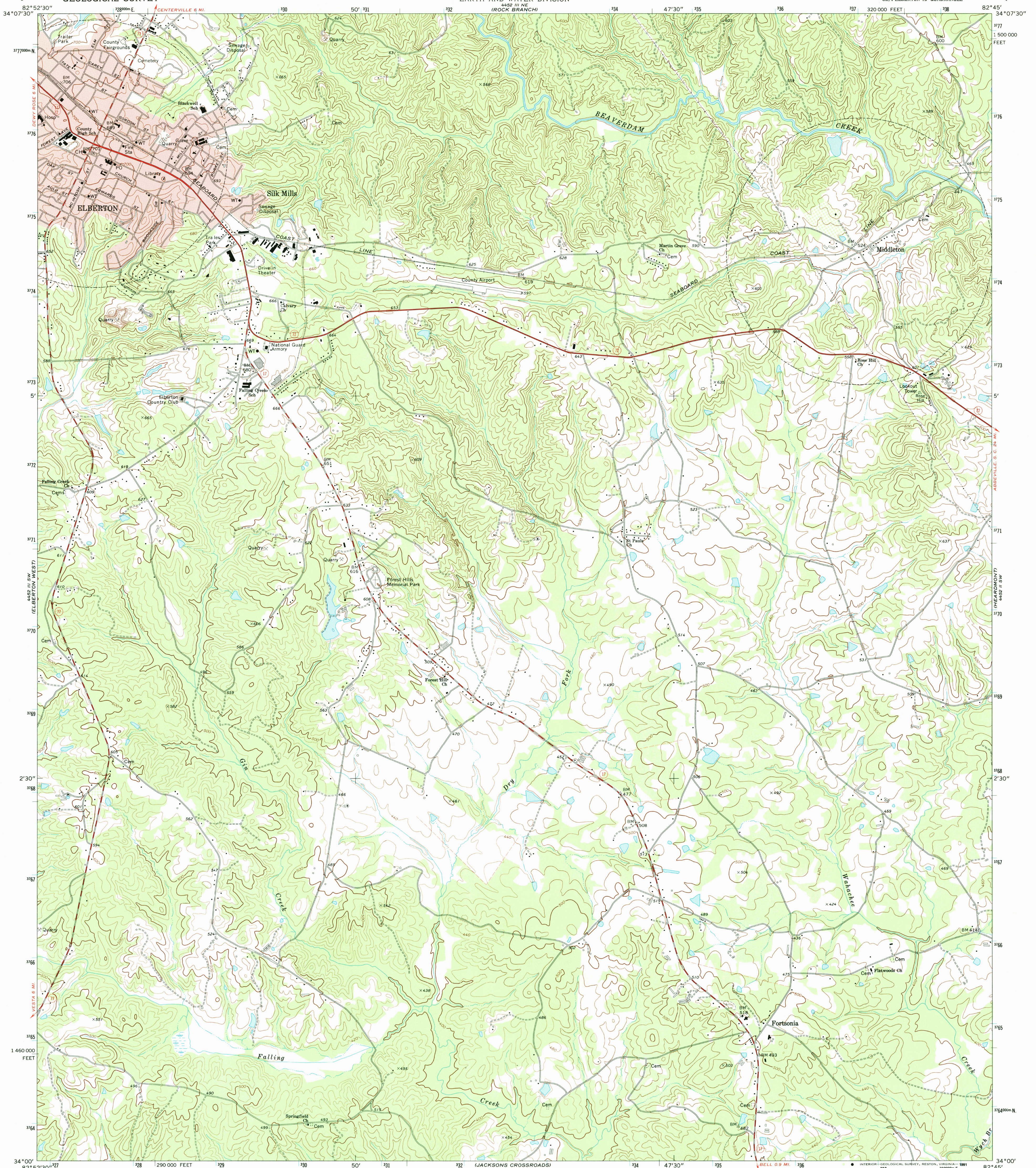

Projection and 10,000-foot grid ticks: Georgia coordinate system, east zone (transverse Mercator)

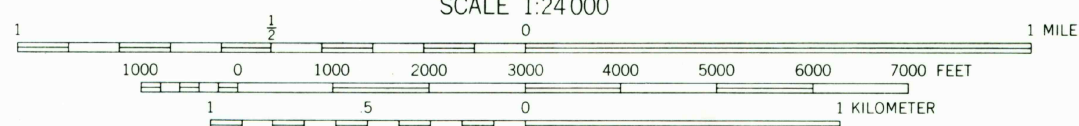
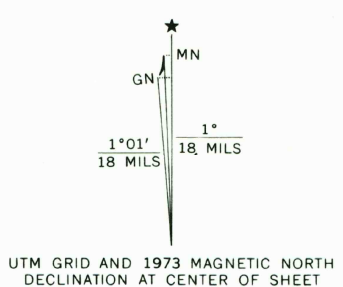
1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks, zone 17, shown in blue. 1927 North American datum

No major culture or drainage changes observed

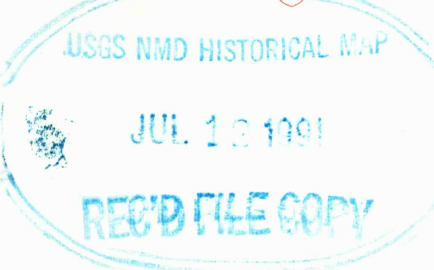
