

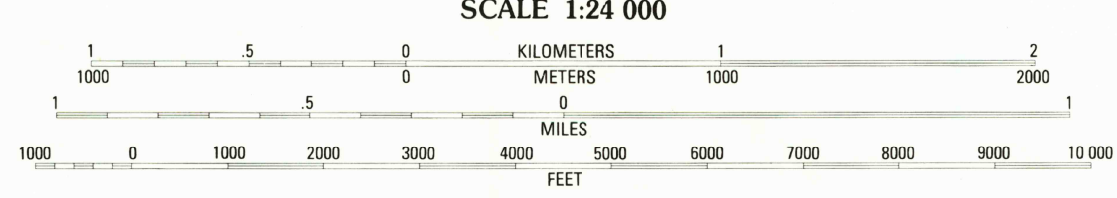
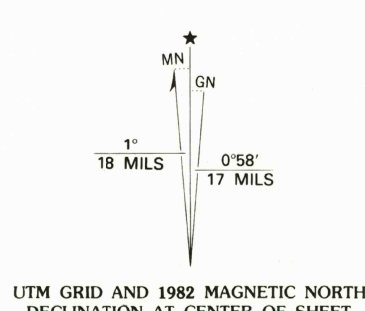

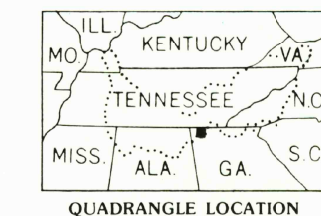
FORT OGLETHORPE QUADRANGLE
