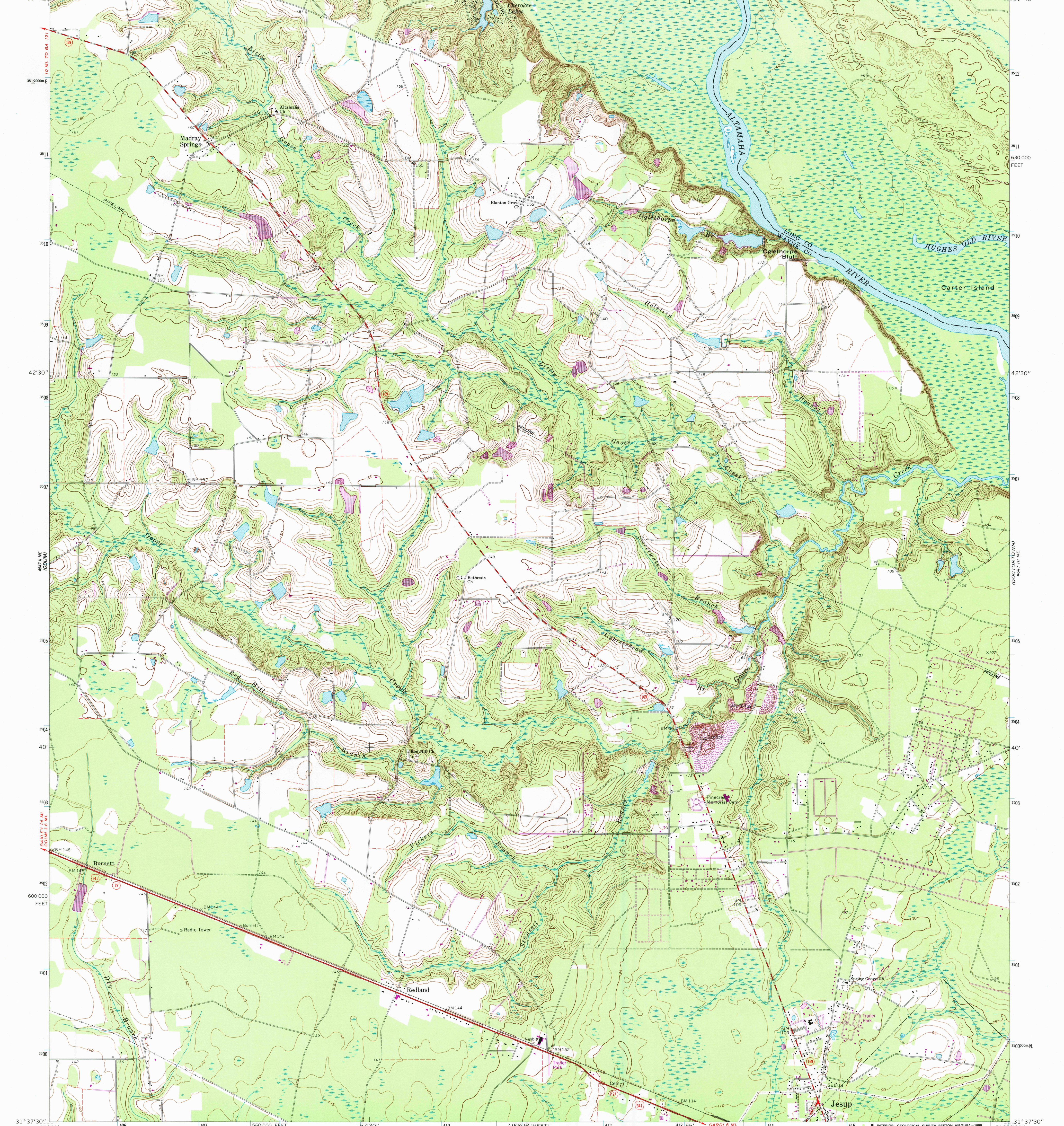

Polyconic projection. 1927 North American datum 10,000-foot grid based on Georgia coordinate system, east zone 1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks, zone 17, shown in blue

To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983, move the projection lines 18 meters south and 15 meters west as shown by dashed corner ticks
