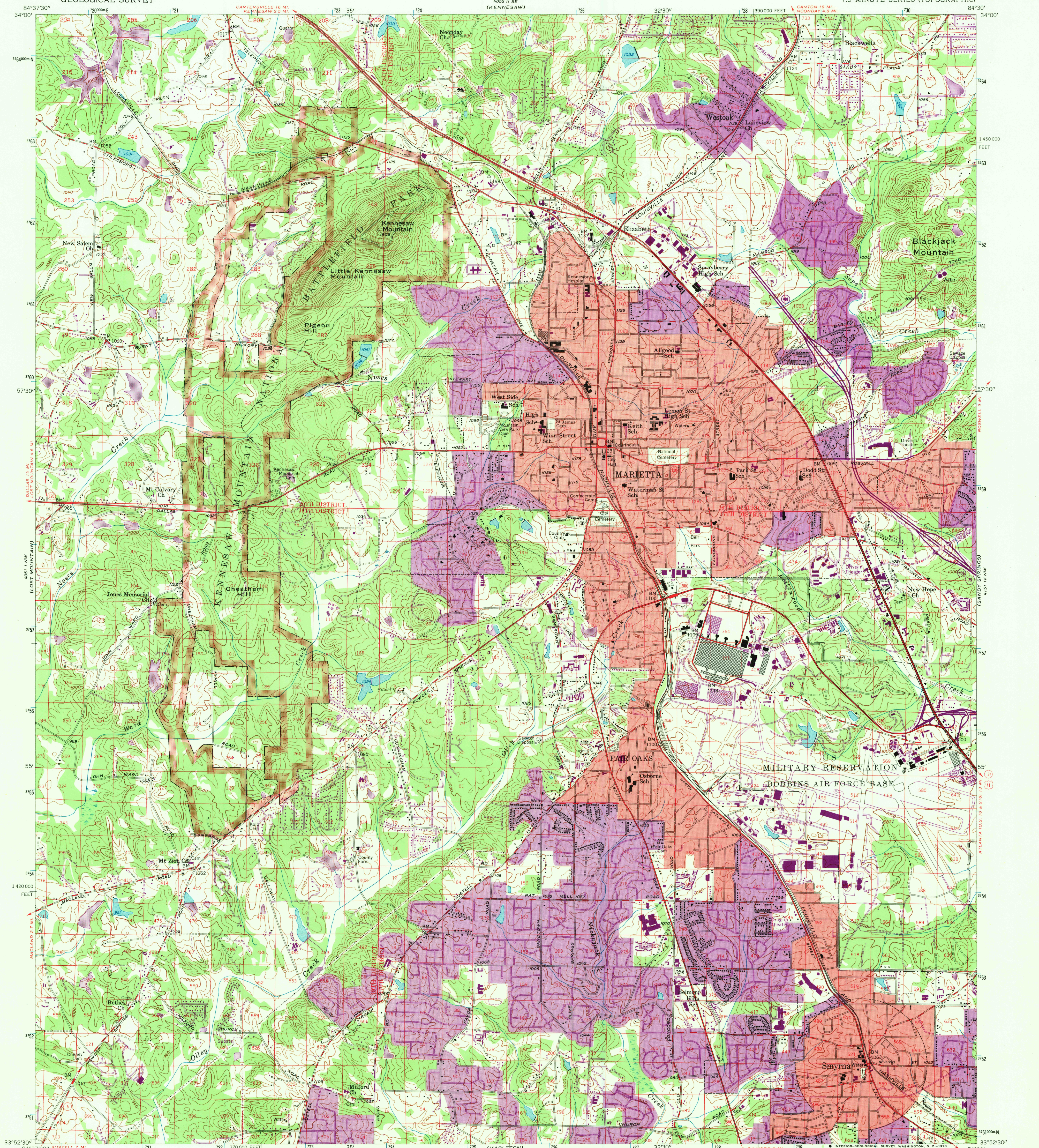

10,000-foot grid based on Georgia coordinate system, west zone

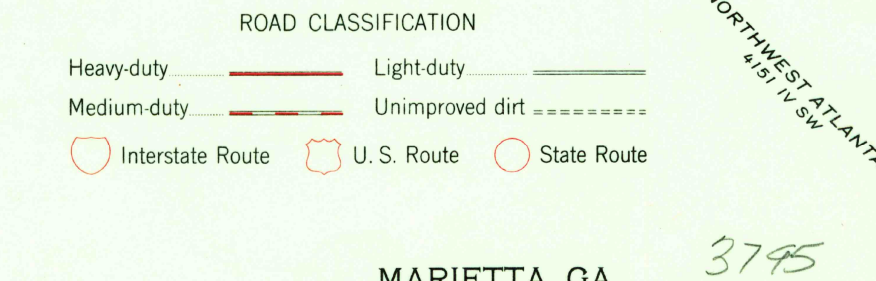
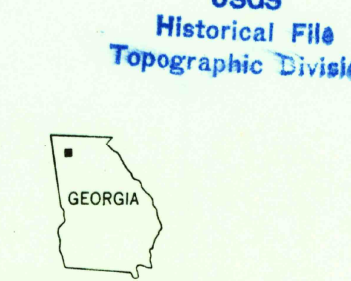
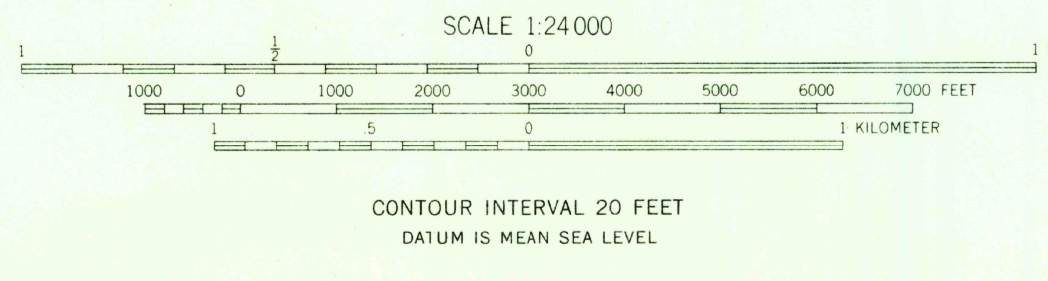
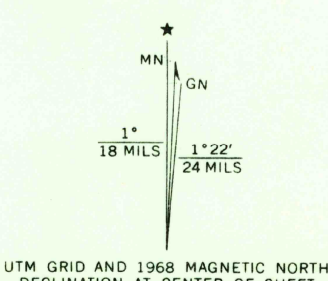
1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks, zone 16, shown in blue
