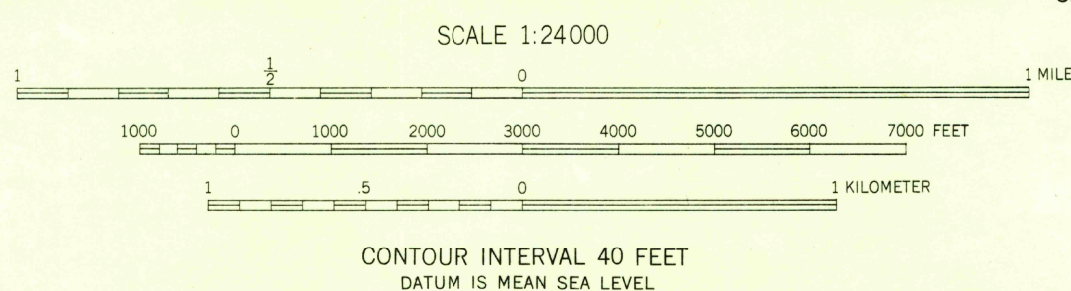
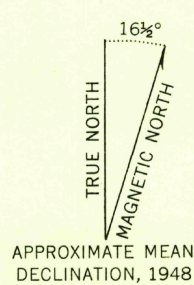

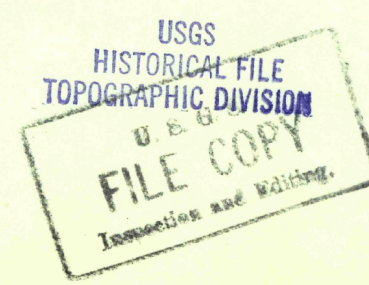
BRIDAL VEIL FALLS QUADRANGLE
