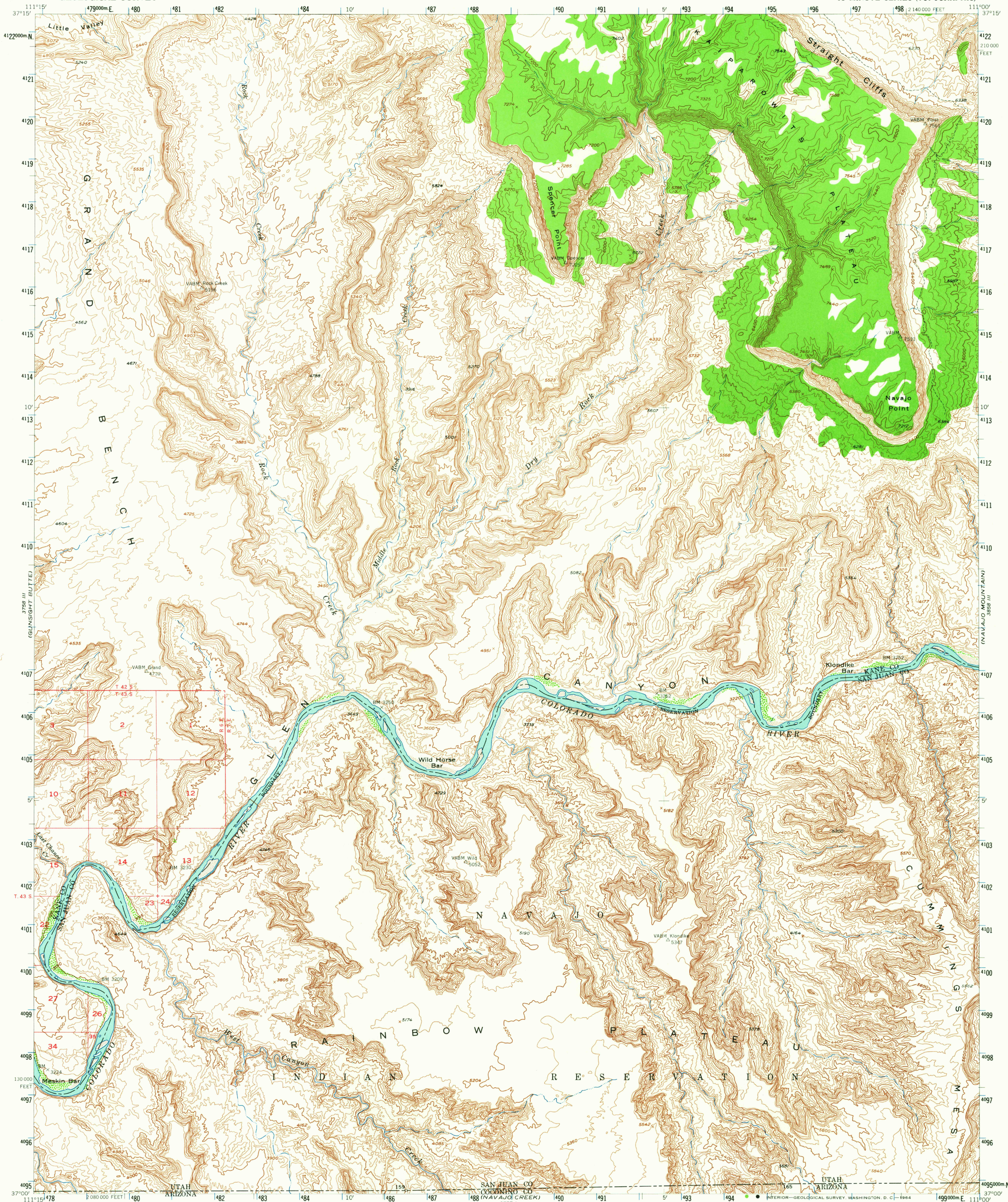

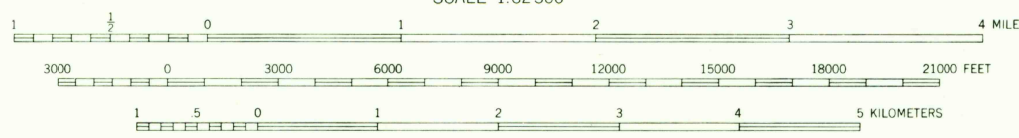
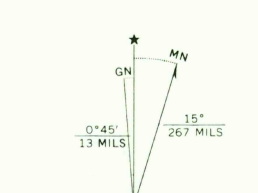
Aerial photographs taken 1951. Advance field check 1953
