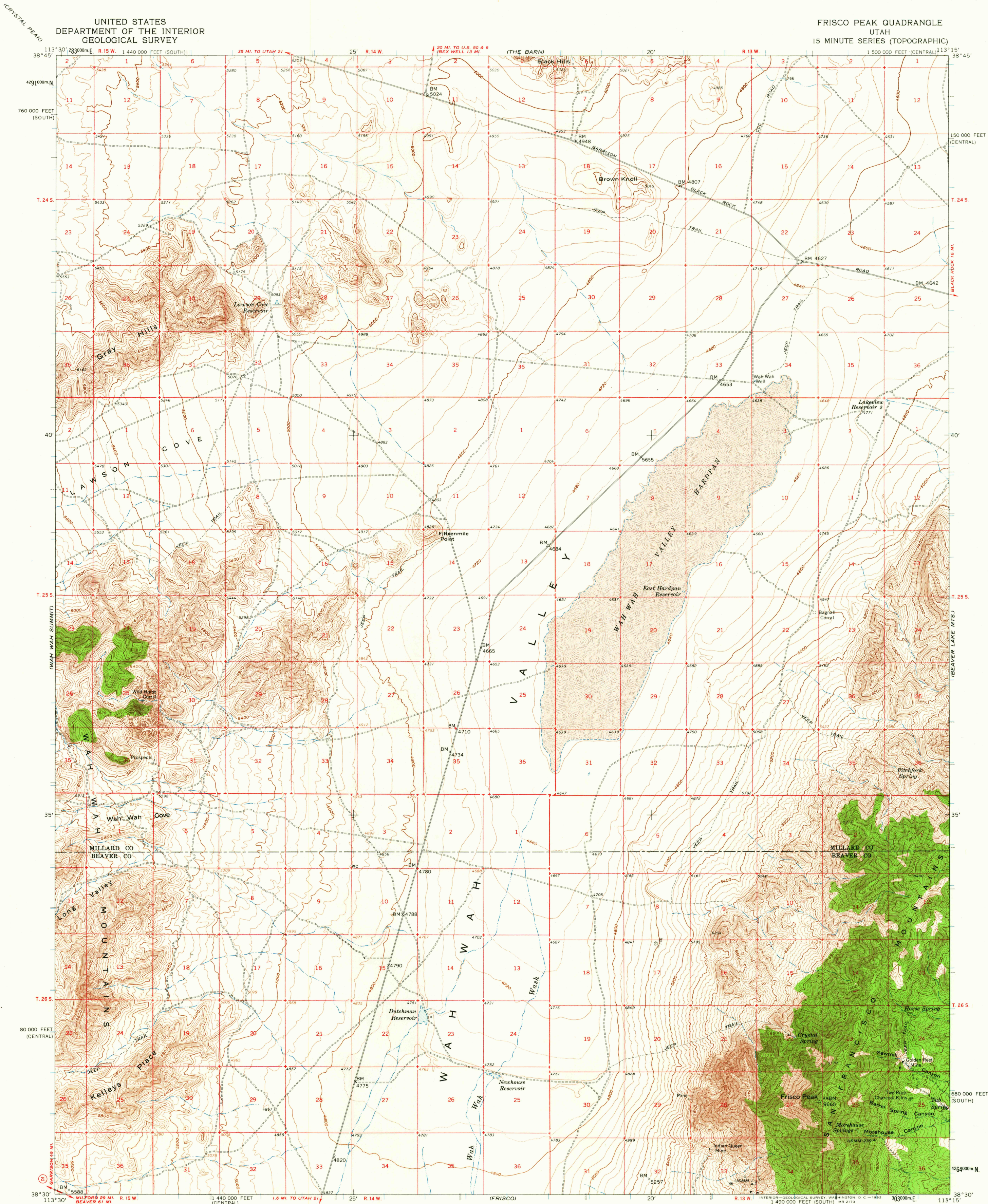




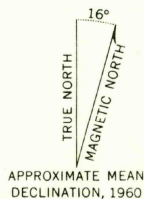

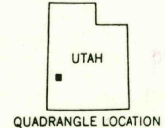
Polyconic projection. 1927 North American datum 10,000-foot grids based on Utah coordinate system, central and south zones
