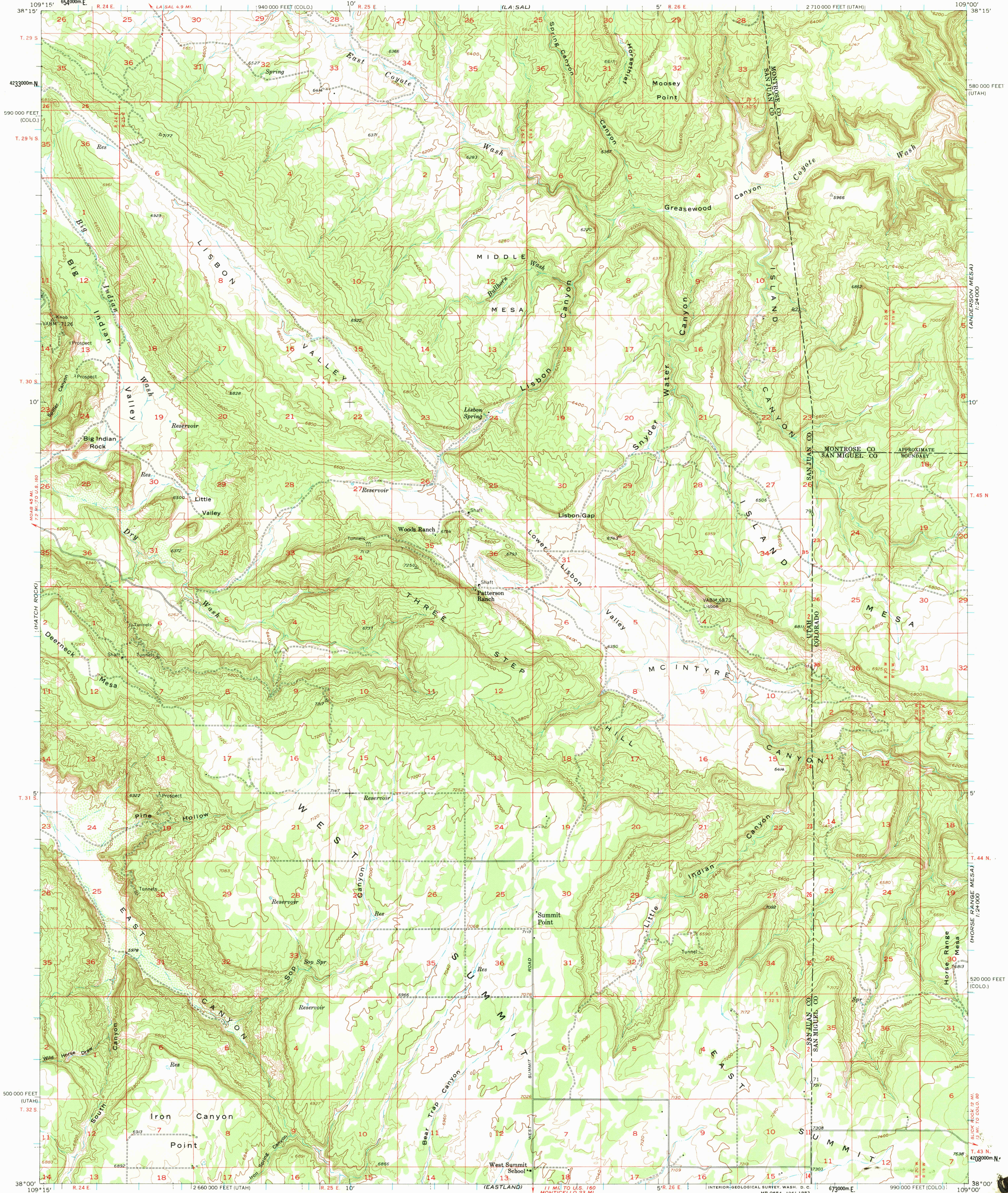

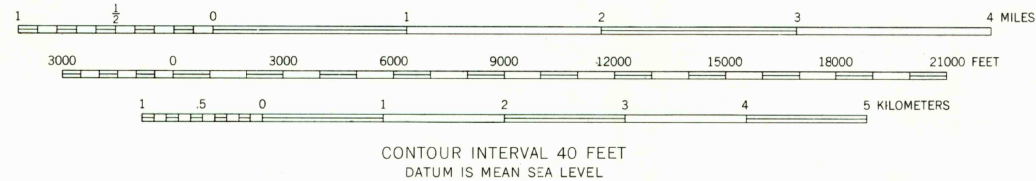
LISBON VALLEY QUADRANGLE
