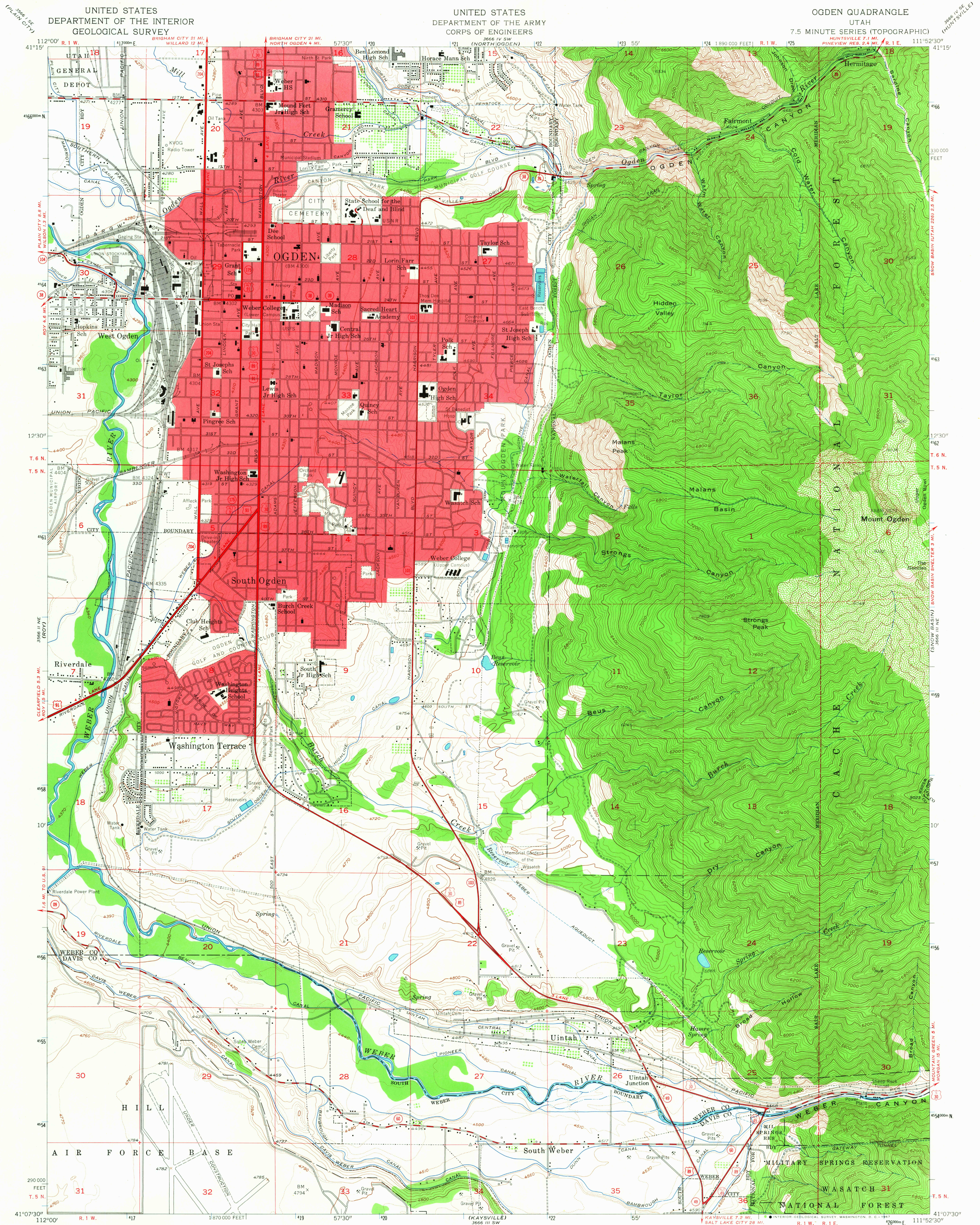

10,000-foot grid based on Utah coordinate system, north zone

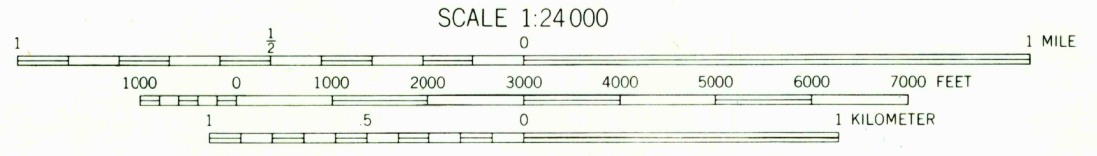
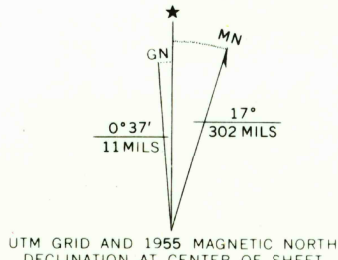
Red tint indicates areas in which only

DASHED LINES REPRESENT 10-FOOT CONTOURS

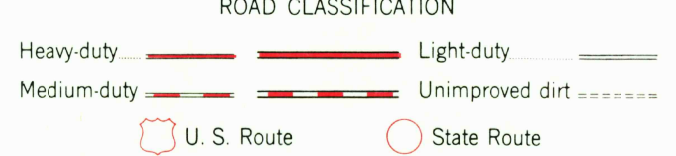

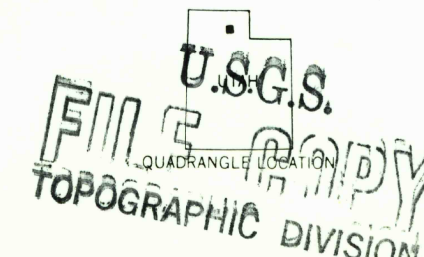
