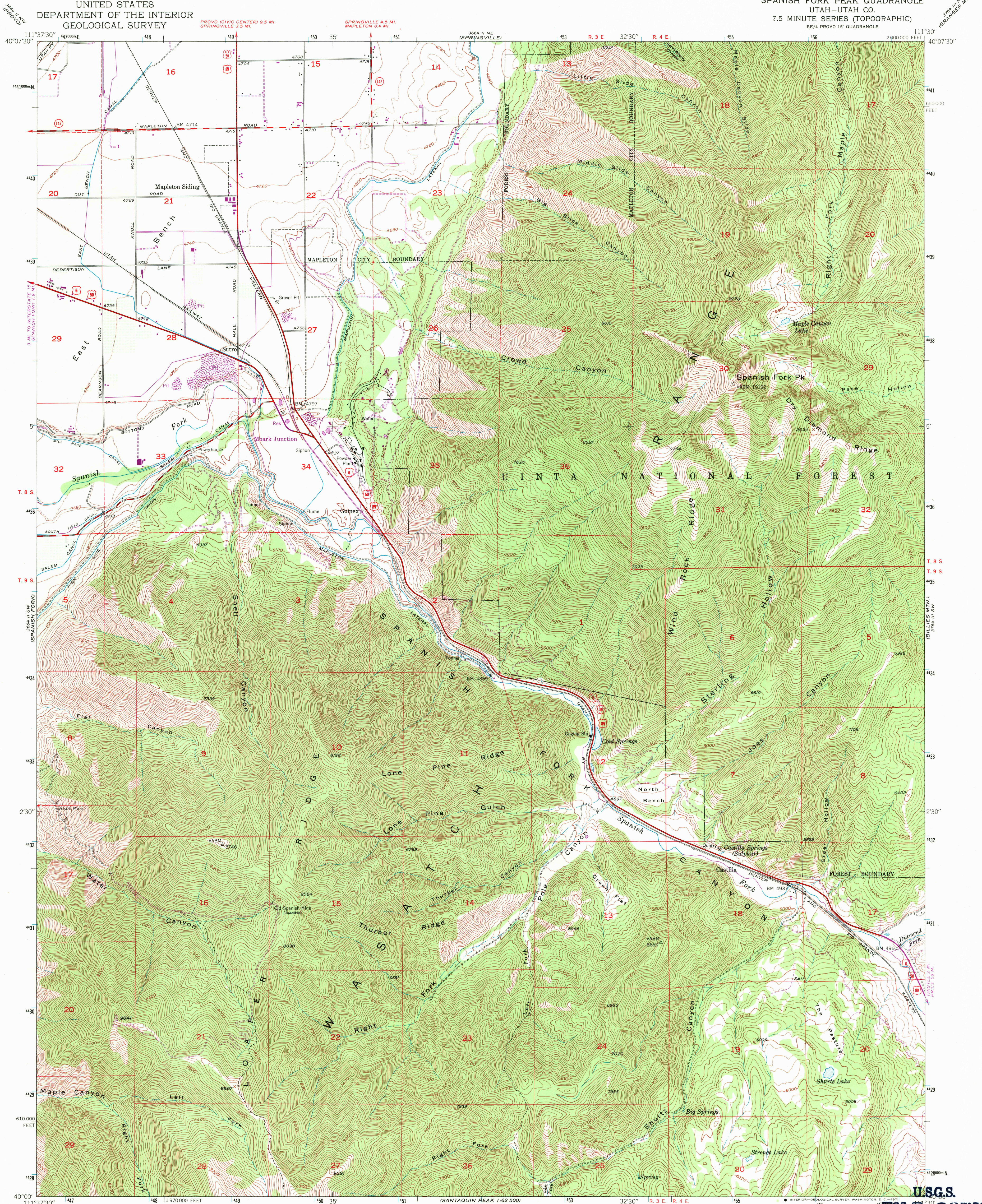

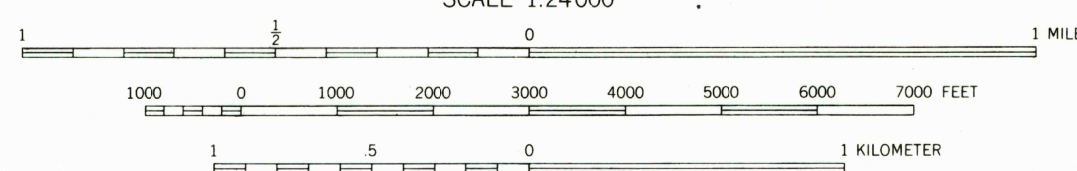
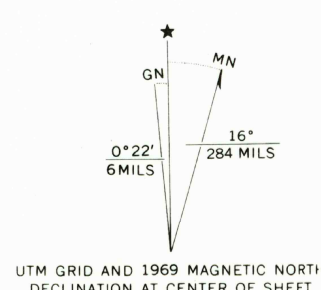

zone 12, shown in blue

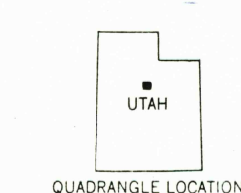
