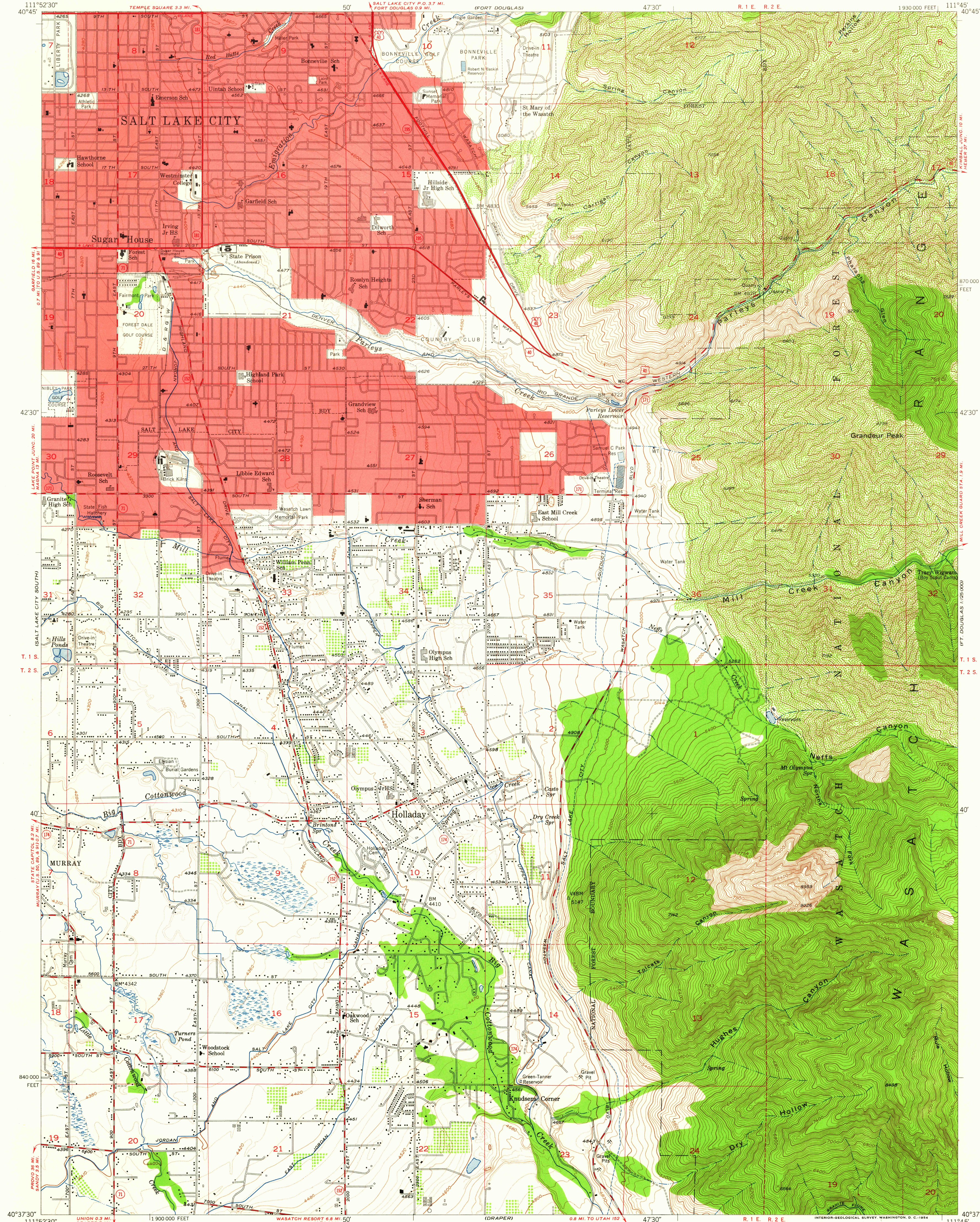

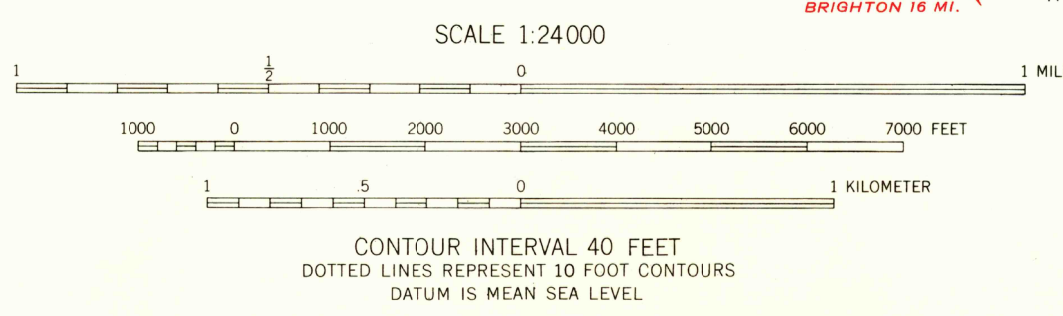
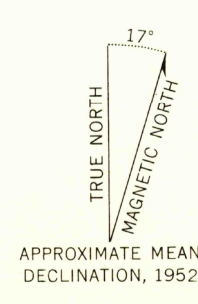
Topography from aerial photographs by multiplex methods

Red tint indicates areas in which only landmark buildings are shown

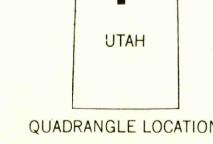
Dashed land lines indicate approximate locations
