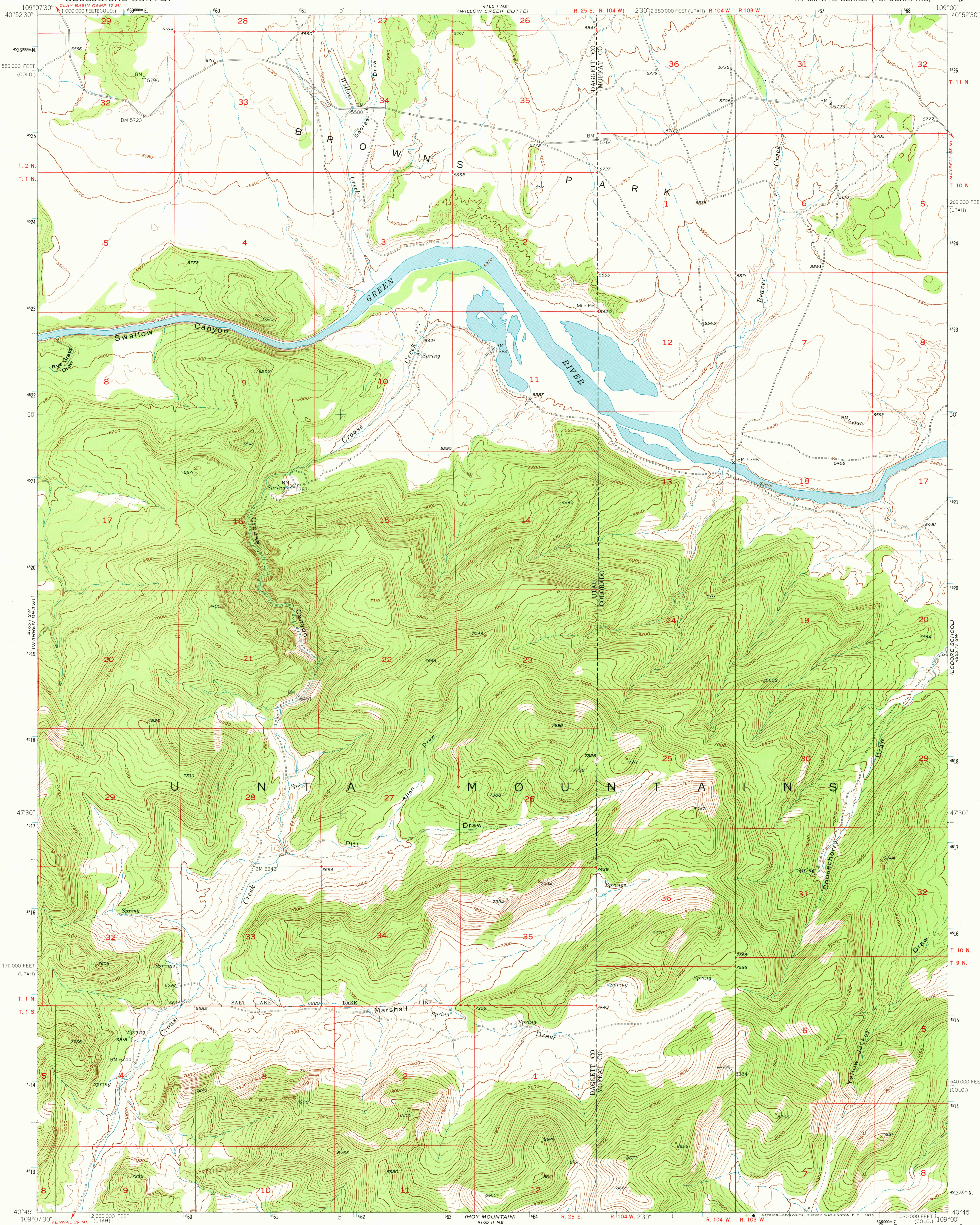

and Colorado coordinate system, north zone

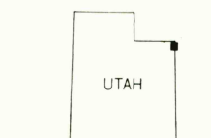
Unchecked elevations are shown in brown
