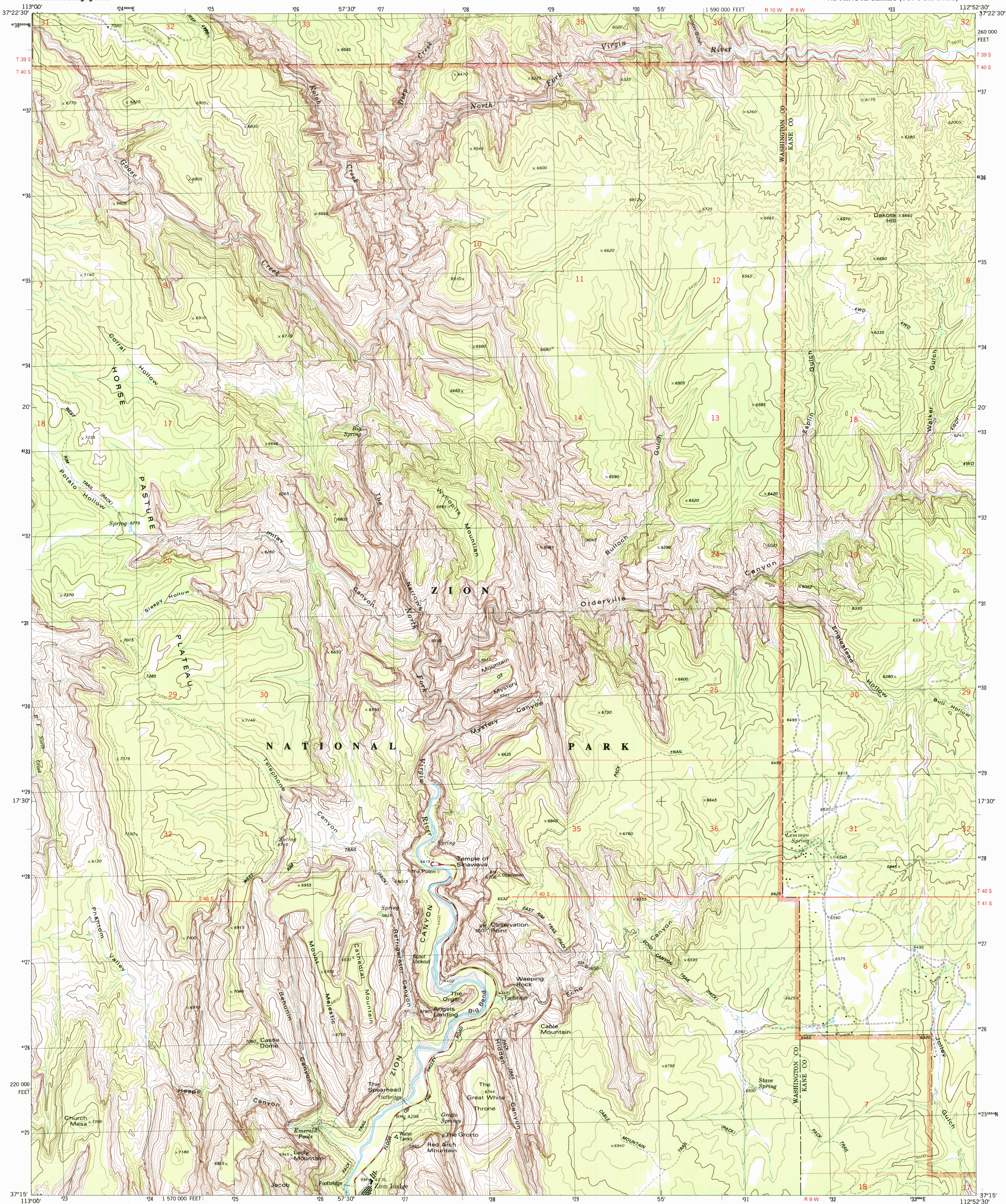


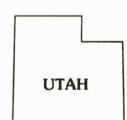
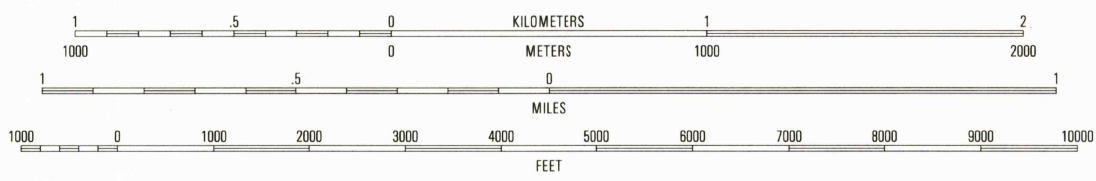
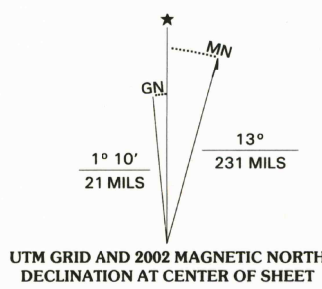


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HISTORICAL MAP ARCHIVES

Produced by the United States Geological Survey
Derived from imagery taken 1973 and other sources. Photoinspected using imagery taken 1997; no major culture or drainage changes observed. Public Land Survey System and survey control current as of 1974. Boundaries verified 2002.
North American Datum of 1927 (NAD 27). Projection and 1 000-meter grid: Universal Transverse Mercator, zone 12 10 000-foot ticks: Utah Coordinate System of 1927 (south zone).
North American Datum of 1983 (NAD 83) is shown by dashed corner ticks. The values of the shift between NAD 27 and NAD 83 for 7.5-minute intersections are obtainable from National Geodetic Survey NADCON software.
