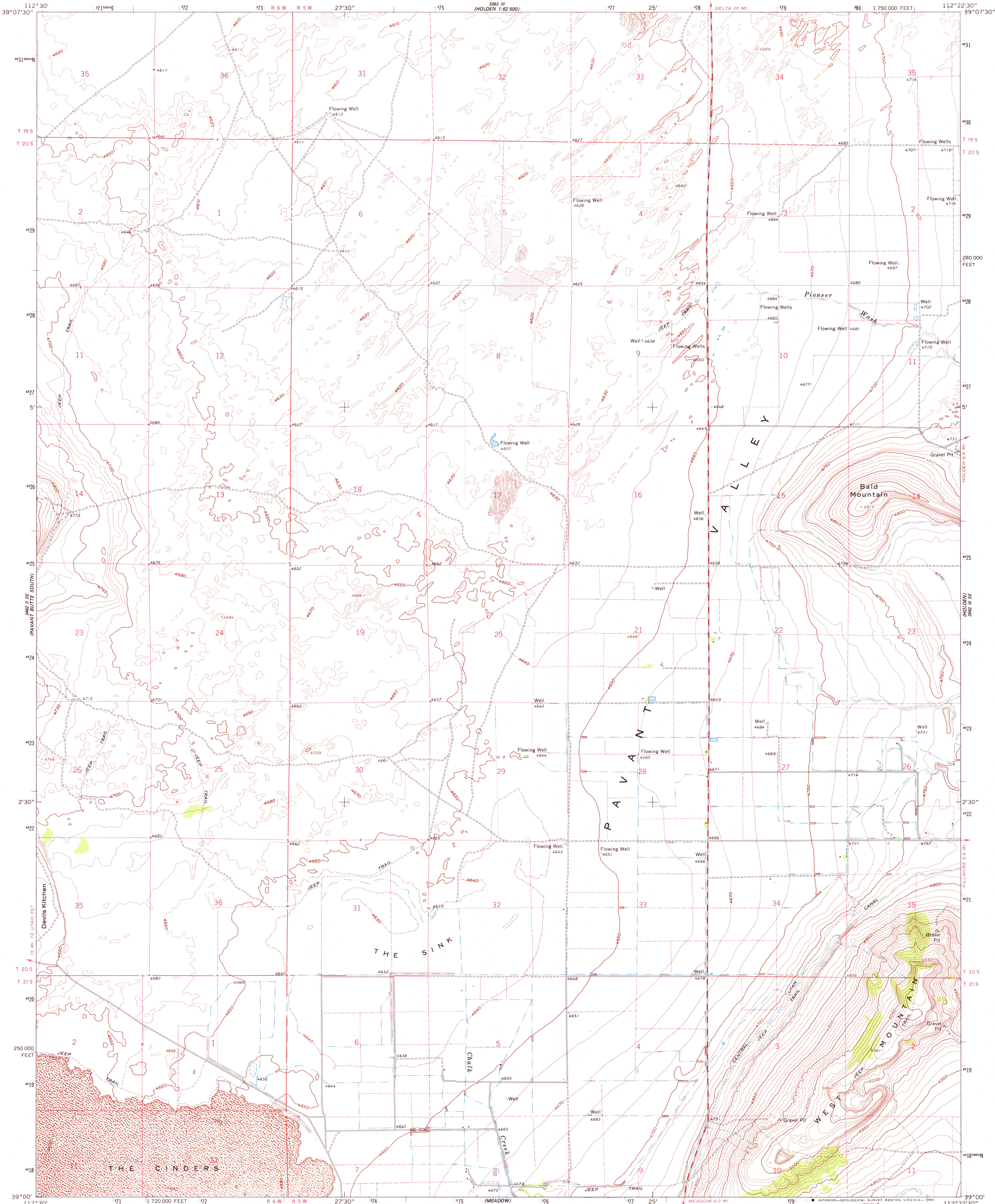

SW 1/4 HOLDEN 15' QUADRANGLE



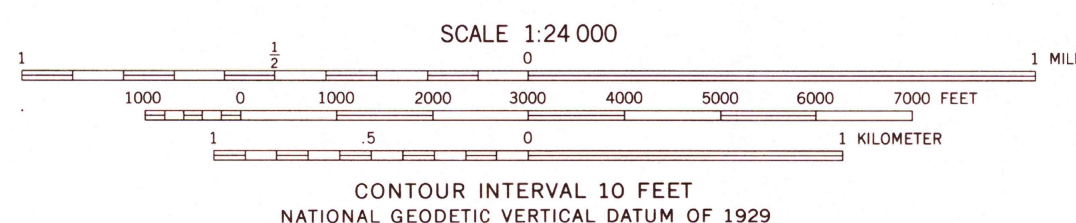
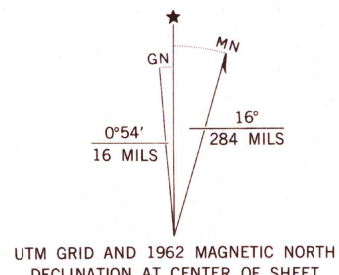
