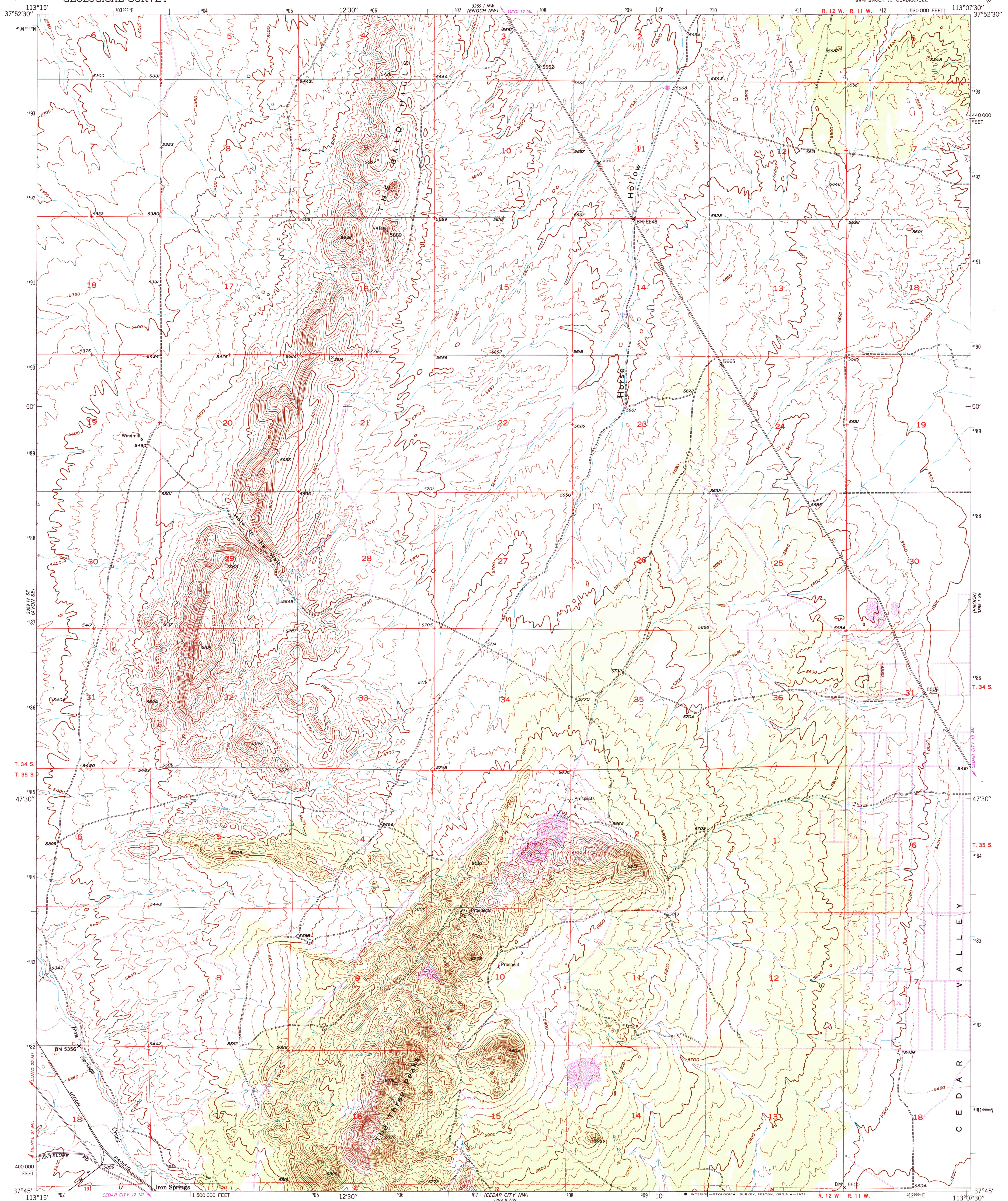

Dashed land lines indicate approximate location

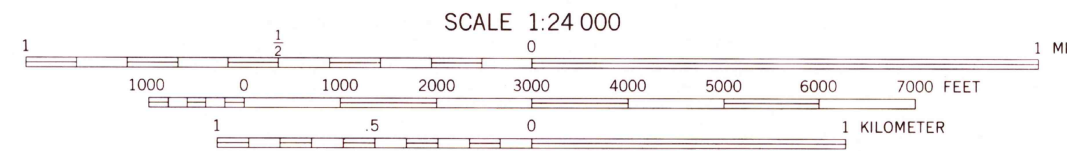
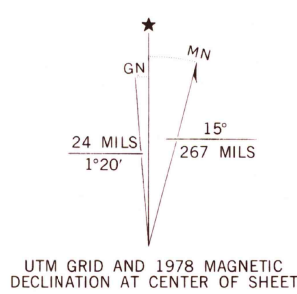
