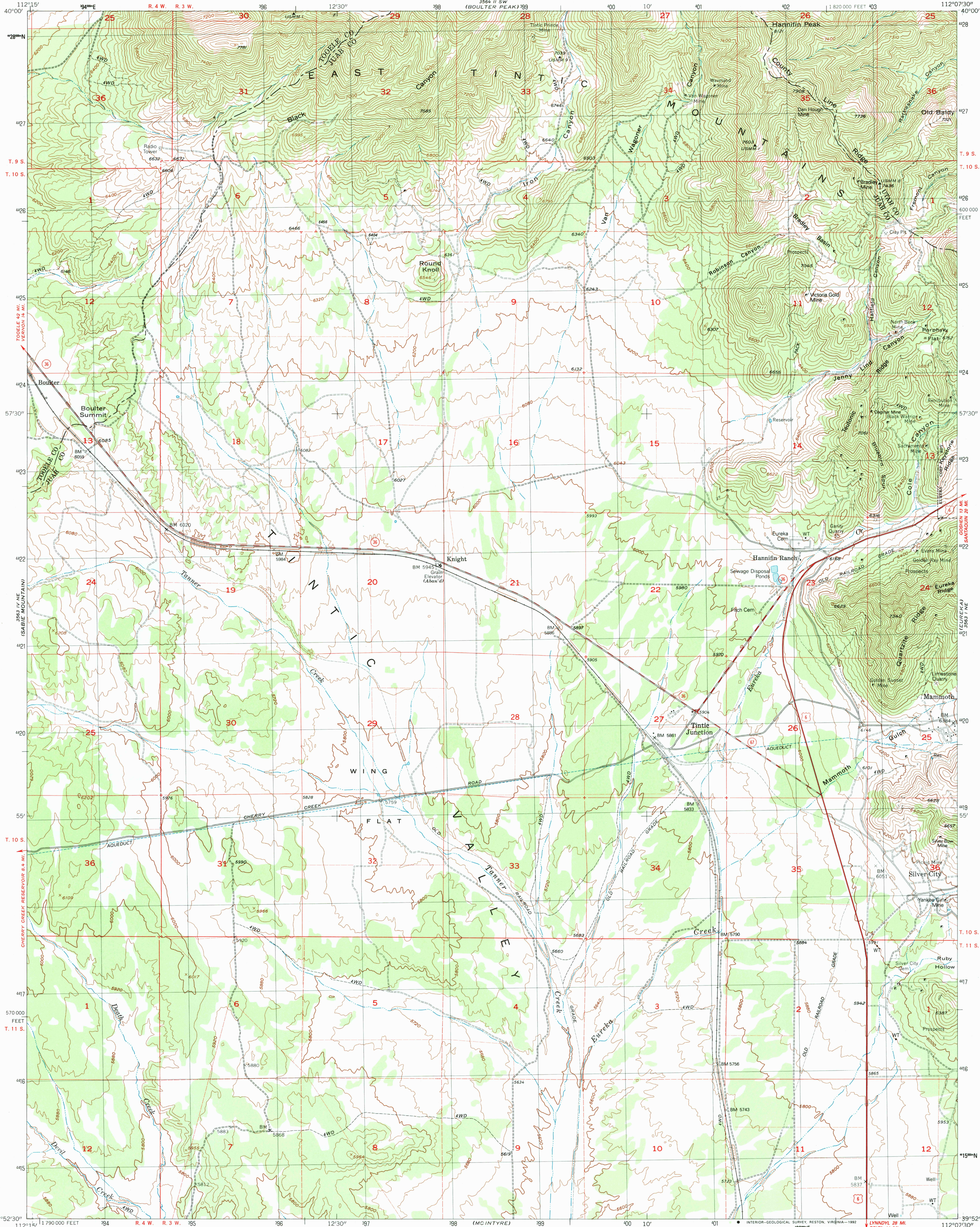
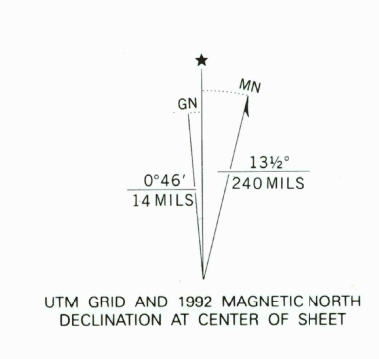

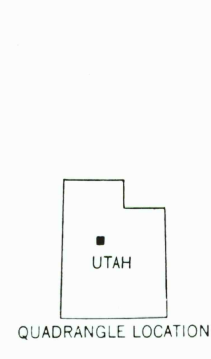
TINTIC JUNCTION QUADRANGLE
