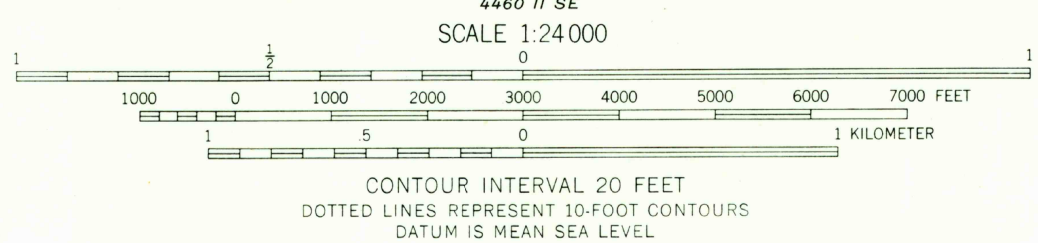
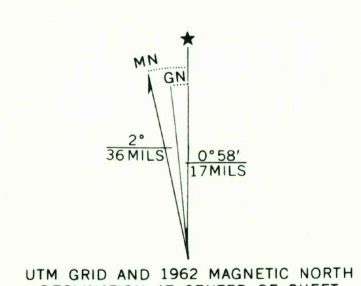




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Topography in West Virginia by photogrammetric methods from aerial photographs taken 1958. Field checked 1962
