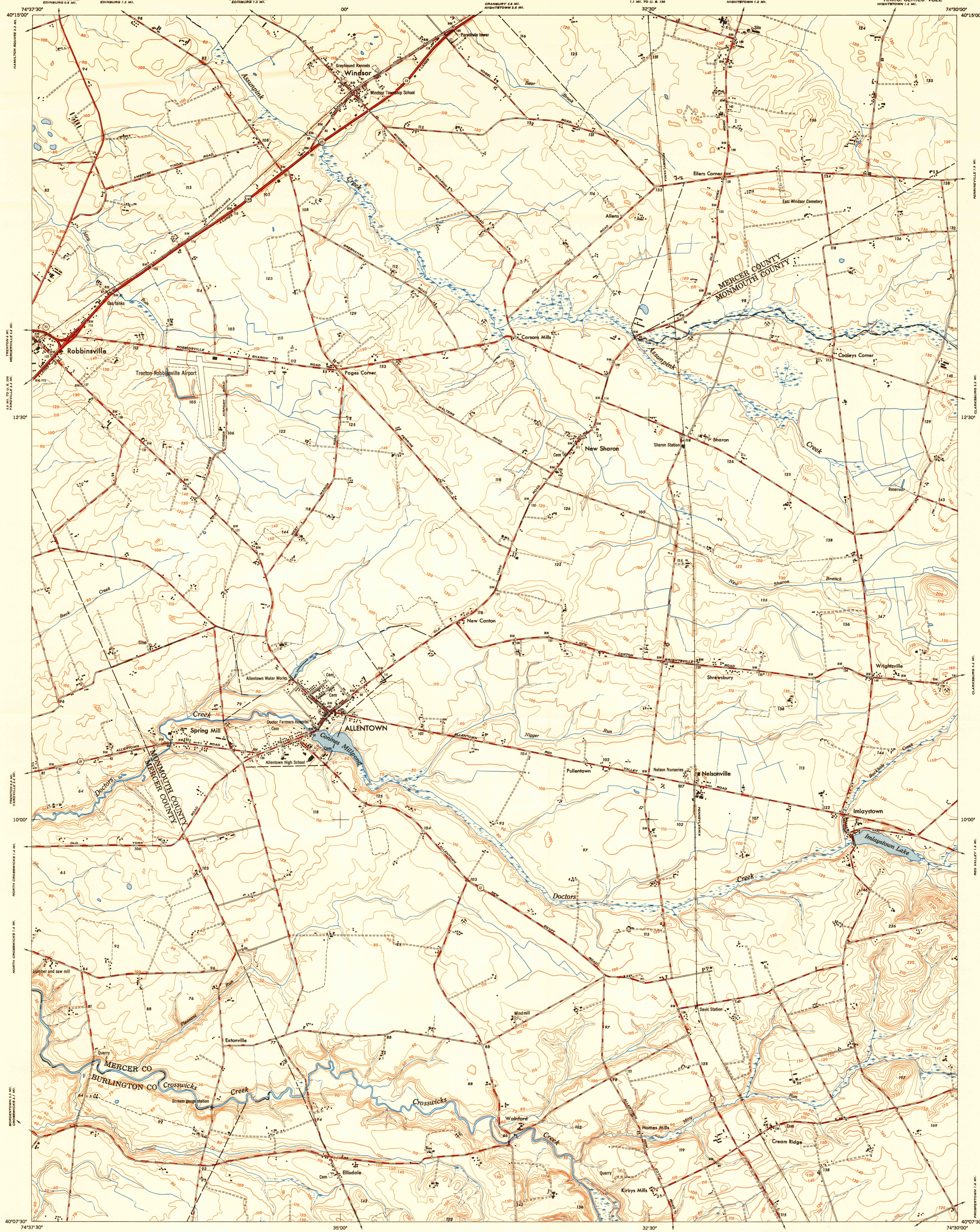
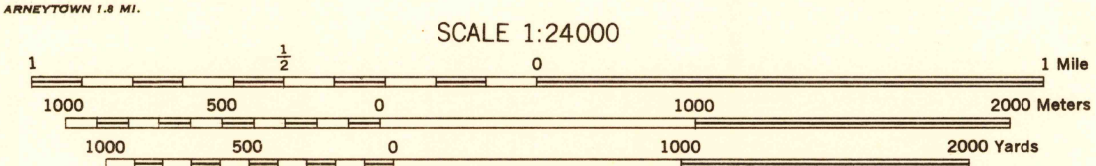




AMS 3, 1948

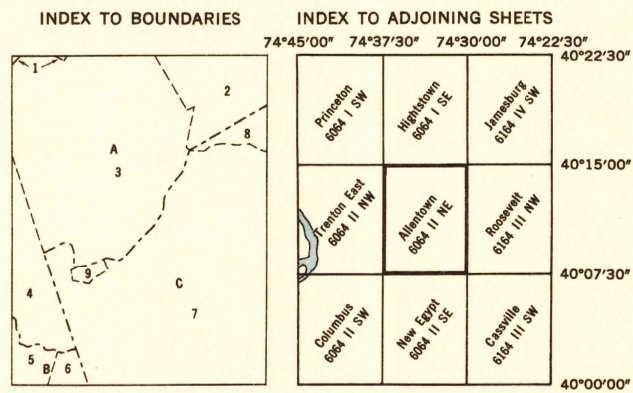
CONTOUR INTERVAL 10 FEET
