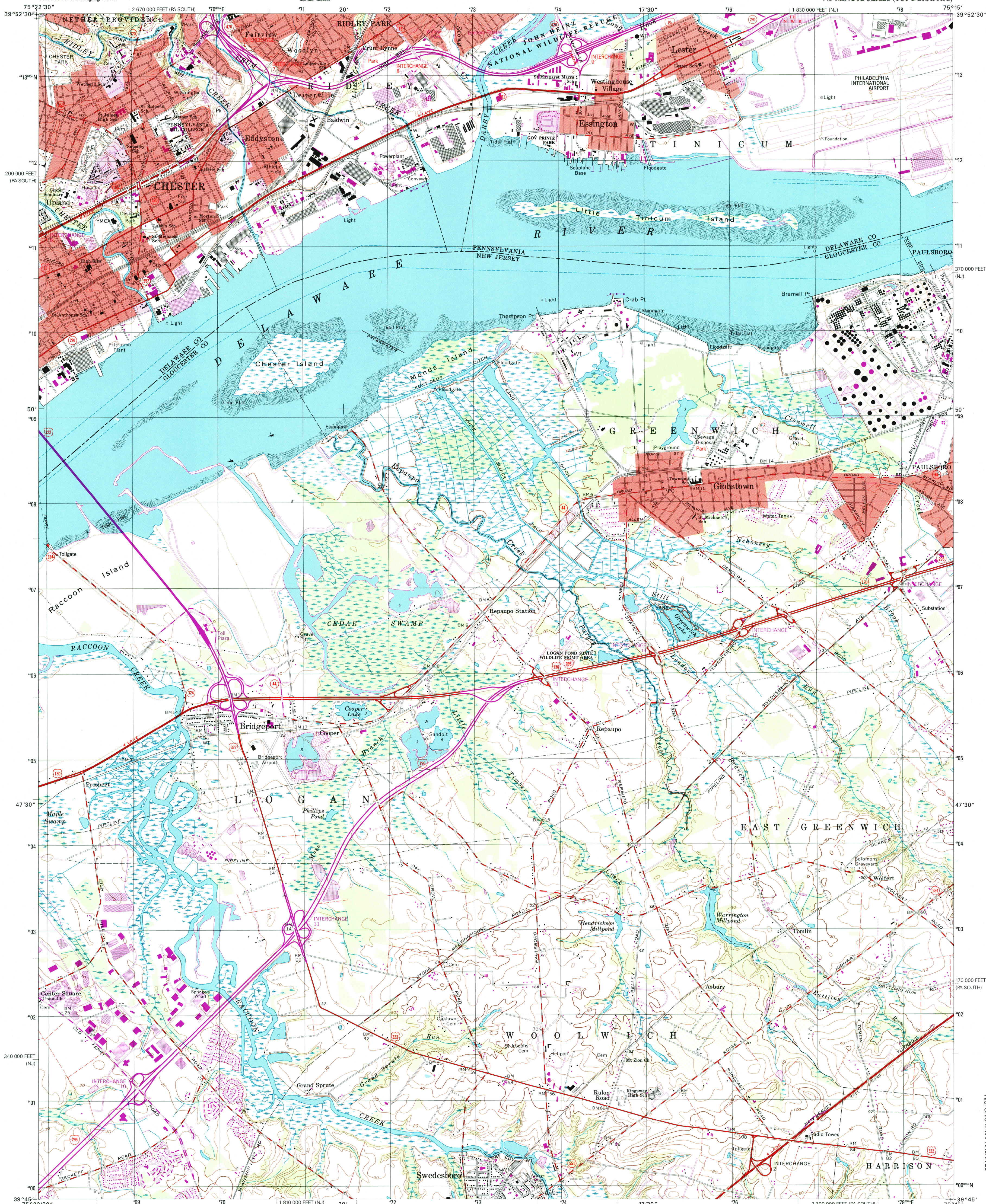

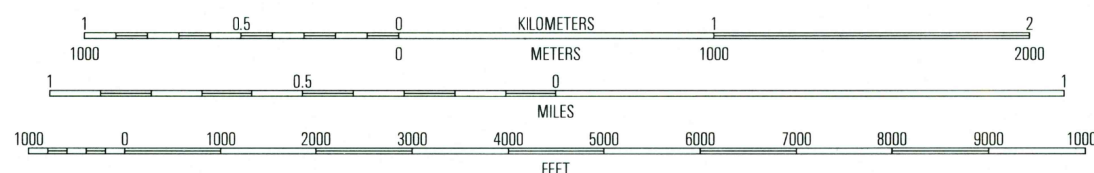
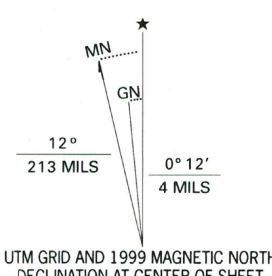
10 000-foot ticks: New Jersey coordinate system, and Pennsylvania coordinate system, south zone
