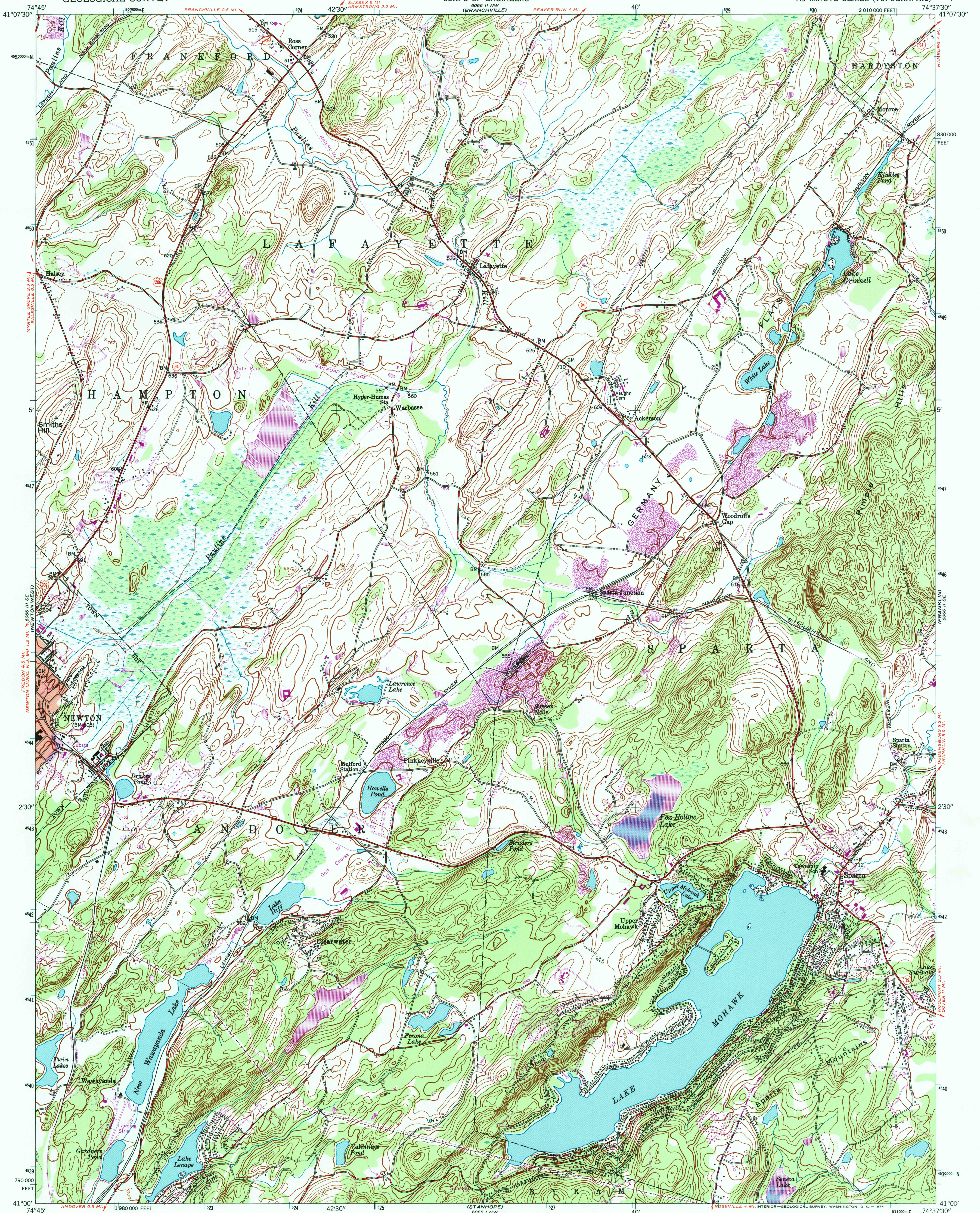

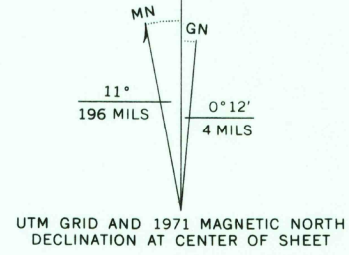

landmark buildings are shown

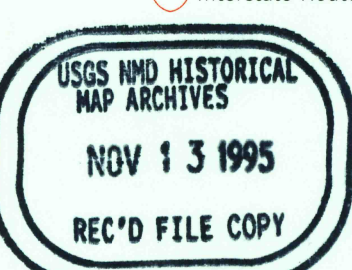
